

## Rental Information

**Owl's Hill** is a lovely outdoor location for your next event. The site is available evenings and weekends for birthday and anniversary parties, rehearsal dinners, receptions, weddings, nature-related workshops and single day retreats.

### Site Rental Fees

M-Th	½ day (4hrs)	\$500.00

### Site rental fee includes:

- Specified area for the specified time
- Preparation of the site
- One staff person on site.
- Use of Owl's Hill tables, trash cans & liners.
- Use of existing portable toilets
- Time to decorate: coordinated with staff
- For weddings: day prior - 1 hour for rehearsal

### Fees for Other Owl's Hill Services

- Additional hours are billed at \$150/hour
- Gate Security (required after 5 PM)  
\$30/hour; 4 hour minimum.
- Parking attendant (required for over 40 cars),  
\$40/hour for 2 attendants; 1 hour minimum.
- Refundable cleaning fee of \$200.00  
For additional details, see rental contract.

Client is responsible for additional portable toilets, tents, additional tables and chairs, etc. All decorations must be taken down and removed by the client at the end of the event.

**Caterer** must show proof of liability insurance.  
**TIPS bartender** required if alcohol is served

## Children's Birthday Parties

Let the staff at Owl's Hill do the work for your child's birthday party. We provide decorations, a nature-related gift for the birthday child, a nature-related favor for each young guest and all the activities. You provide food, tableware and guests. Seasonal Party themes range from Owls to Butterflies. The rental fee covers 20 young guests and six adults; additional guests are billed at \$5-\$7\*\*, depending on the party theme. ### Adult Club Programs

Clubs meeting during our regular weekday business hours may rent the site for our minimum group fee of \$50. This secures the Gathering Pavilion for 2 hours. In less clement weather, the Visitor Center is available for groups of 20 or less. For an additional \$50, clubs may add a program to their meeting. Choose from an Owl Program, a Backyard Bird Program, a Bluebird Program, a Butterfly Program or an All About Owl's Hill Program. During the Spring Wildflower season and the Autumn Foliage season, site tours may be arranged for a per person fee of \$7.

### Photographers and Artists

Individual photographers and artists with reservations are welcome during our regular weekday business hours for a fee of \$50. Sanctuary rules apply. There are no reservations available after hours or on weekends.

## Facilities

- Events are held in our Russell Gathering Pavilion. Gatherings with up to 20 people may be held in the Visitor Center.
- The Pavilion is lighted, has 3 electric outlets and can accommodate up to 80 people. Tent rental expands the usable space.
- We have limited refrigerator and freezer space. Please discuss your needs with us in advance.
- We have portable toilets only; they are located in the orchard and by the barn.

### Preparing for Your Visit

Owl's Hill is a protected natural area. Plants that scratch, prick, and make you itch as well as animals that bite and sting live undisturbed in this unique sanctuary. Trails are unpaved. Owl's Hill is not liable for injury to guests who encounter these elements in the Sanctuary. Your visit to this peaceful acreage will be more comfortable and pleasant if you arrive prepared for the experience.

- Dress for the outdoors.
- Be weather-wise
- Wear sturdy closed-toe shoes and socks, boots for cold or rain if you will be hiking.
- Use insect repellent for visits between April 1 and October 15.

### Visitor Rules

We try to keep our rules simple and few!

- Stay behind the leader and/or on the trails
- Do not pick anything.
- Do not take anything away that you find.
- Do not throw objects, especially rocks, even into the ponds.
- Do not disturb bird-nesting boxes.
- No Balloons
- No Piñatas
- No Confetti.
