Notes: Cumberland enters Wednesday's contest against Lambuth ranked fourth nationally after the first NAIA Coaches Top 25 of the regular season was released this week ... Cumberland leads the series with Lambuth, 14-2, over the last six seasons, including 8-0 at Ernest L. Stockton Field ... The Bulldogs won 2-of-3 from the Eagles last season in Jackson and swept Lambuth in a three-game series at home in 2008.

Cumberland ranked No. 4 nationally

Cumberland jumped 15 spots and is ranked fourth nationally in the first regular season 2010 NAIA Baseball Coaches' Top 25 Poll released Tuesday by the national office. The ranking is the highest for the Bulldogs since earning the second spot in the preseason poll in 2007. The Bulldogs already have six victories this season over ranked opponents – three versus No. 3 Oklahoma City Univ., two against seventh-ranked Embry-Riddle and one versus No. 8 Campbellsville Univ. CU will host 13th-ranked Bethel Univ. this weekend in a three-game series, No. 8 Lee Univ. next Tuesday and 25th-ranked Milligan College on April 27. CU just won 2-of-3 over 19th-ranked Union Univ. Cumberland was ranked 19th in the NAIA Baseball Coaches' Top 25 Preseason Poll released in November.

Bulldogs sweep TranSouth honors again

Seniors Matt Greener and Shawn Schaefer were named the TranSouth Conference Player and Pitcher of the Week, respectively, Monday for the second straight week. The award is Schaefer's fourth of the season and Greener's third, and the Bulldogs have now won eight of the league's 12 POW honors so far this year. Greener batted .571 (12-for-21) in five games during the week with three home runs, three doubles and 11 RBIs. He also scored six times and extended his hitting streak to 19 games in the process. He was 5-for-11 (.455) with four extra base hits, two RBIs and four runs scored at Union University, as the Bulldogs won 2-of-3 to start TranSouth Conference action. Schaefer won his sixth straight start, scattering seven hits and striking out 11 in a 2-0, nine-inning victory at Union on Friday. The lefthander allowed more than one baserunner in just one inning, the fifth, while tossing his fifth straight complete game. He lowered his ERA to

0.84, which ranks fifth nationally, and has allowed just 24 hits in 42.2 innings of work this season with 43 strikeouts.

Greener's numbers continue to astound

Senior Matt Greener has continued his assault on opponents through the month of March, batting .482 with 26 extra-base hits, 47 RBIs and 33 runs scored through 31 contests. The Jupiter, Fla., native ranks in the Top 16 nationally in seven categories, including second in total bases (104) and slugging percentage (.945), fourth in RBIs, tied for fourth in home runs (12), tied for fifth in hits (53), tied for 15th in doubles (13) and 16th in batting average. Greener has hit safely in 30 of the 31 contests and currently has a 19-game hitting streak, during which he is batting .507 (37-for-73) with nine doubles, nine homers, 32 RBIs and 21 runs scored. He has 16 multi-hit and 10 multi-RBI games this season as well. Greener was 5-for-11 (.455) with four extra base hits, two RBIs and four runs scored at Union last weekend in the opening TranSouth series of the year. He leads the Bulldogs in every major offensive category except runs scored (33), where he is tied for second with two others.

Schaefer keeps dominating

Senior Shawn Schaefer posted another dominating performance in Friday's 2-0, nine-inning shutout at Union Univ., scattering seven hits while walking two and striking out 11, his second double-digit strikeout performance of the season. The lefthander has tossed five straight complete games and has allowed just 24 hits in 42.2 innings this season with 43 strikeouts and just eight walks. He has given up just six extra-base hits, all doubles, and opponents are batting only .160. He lowered his ERA to 0.84, which ranks fourth nationally, with the opponent

batting average ninth best in the nation. He ranks eighth in hits allowed per nine innings (5.06), tied for seventh in victories and tied for eighth in earned runs allowed per game (0.67). Schaefer has faced just one sub-.500 team so far this season, Davenport Univ., posting his exquisite numbers against the likes of Division II North Alabama, Missouri Baptist, Oklahoma City Univ., Embry-Riddle and Union.

Big inning marks series victory

After winning Friday's conference opener at Union Univ., 2-0, behind another strong performance from Shawn Schaefer, Cumberland found itself in a back-and-forth affair in the first game of Saturday's doubleheader at Fesmire Field. But the Bulldogs exploded for 11 runs in the fourth inning to take a 16-5, five-inning triumph and the

series clincher. The most amazing part to the inning was that the first two batters were retired in order before CU had 11 consecutive registered hits. T.J. Murphy and Sam Kikla both singled to start the rally and Troy Frazier gave the Bulldogs the lead for good with a three-run home run. Kris Miller and Matt Greener had back-to-back doubles and Brian Karahalios followed with an RBI single. David Fanshawe then singled before a two-run double by Greg Appleton and an RBI single from Max Kautz. Murphy singled for the second time in the inning and Kikla capped the scoring with another three-run homer.

Kikla does a little of everything

ESPN's Dick Vitale coined the phrase stat-sheet stuffer for basketball players who register in multiple statistical categories. Bulldog senior

Sam Kikla fits the bill on the baseball field after leading the club in nine offensive categories last season. The Malabar, Fla., native has kept up the good work in 2010 as well, batting .371 and leading the Bulldogs with 45 runs scored while ranking second on the team with 16 walks. He has also been hit nine times and has a .492 on-base percentage, third best on the squad. Kikla has added six doubles, nine home runs and 33 RBIs and is tied for the team lead with seven stolen bases. After going through an eight-game stretch with just four hits in 27 at-bats (.148), he has rebounded with 17 hits in his last 37 at-bats (.459) over 10 outings with four home runs, 12 RBIs and 17 runs scored. Kikla had five hits, drove in four runs, homered twice and scored five times in the series victory at Union Univ. last weekend.

Post's return uneven

Senior Robert Post started for the first time last Saturday at Union Univ. in his first significant action since March 6 at Oklahoma City Univ. when the left after just one inning of work. The righthander allowed six runs on nine hits in 3.2 innings, walking one and striking out three. He took the loss in a 7-5 CU defeat. The Mt. Juliet, Tenn., native was very sharp in his opening start of the season, tossing a three-hit shutout with six strikeouts against the Univ. of St. Francis. He was not as sharp in his second outing, giving up four unearned runs and seven hits in a victory over Viterbo Univ. before running into trouble against the Stars, giving up three runs on three hits to OCU and taking the loss in a 10-7 defeat. For the season Post is 2-2 with a 3.86 ERA with 15 strikeouts in 18.2 innings of work.

Appleton doubles his pleasure

Junior Greg Appleton has become a mainstay at the bottom of the Bulldog lineup, helping set the table for players like Sam Kikla and Max Kautz, who have a combined 51 RBIs in the top two spots in the order. The Port Coquitlam, British Columbia, native had slumped a little recently, collecting just four hits in 16 at-bats (.250) over a seven-game stretch from March 15-24. But Appleton came up with big hits in CU's series at Union Univ. over the weekend, including a double in each contest. He had four total hits in the three games, drove in three runs and scored twice. He has raised his season average to .317 with five doubles, six home runs, 20 RBIs and 18 runs scored in 22 starts this season.

Wilkerson chalks up another victory

Junior Aaron Wilkerson helped the Bulldogs

secure a series victory over Union Univ. last weekend with the victory, though it was not the dominating performance of his last two starts. The righthander allowed five runs, two earned, on seven hits while walking two and striking out six. Wilkerson was the benefactor of an 11-run fourth inning by the Bulldogs, which turned a 5-5 contest into a run-rule victory for CU. Union scored three unearned runs in the second inning after a two-out error and a two-run single. Wilkerson retired the final eight batters of the game in order for his fourth victory. He is now 4-1 on the season with a 2.23 ERA, striking out 42 in 32.1 innings of work with opponents batting just .216.

Fanshawe finds his stroke

Junior David Fanshawe has done a superb job behind the plate this season, helping the pitching staff post a 3.39 ERA with 202 strikeouts and just 63 walks through 223.0 innings of work. The Miami, Fla., native was also a big contributor at the plate through the first 22 games of the year, batting .375 with five doubles and 13 RBIs as well as eight walks. But Fanshawe went through a bad stretch from March 16-24, collecting just three hits in 23 at-bats (.130) with one double, two RBIs and three walks. But he came out of the funk at the right time, registering four hits with a double in last weekend's series at Union Univ. to raise his season average to .320. He also has seven doubles and 15 RBIs while starting 26 of the team's 31 games behind the plate.

Murphy's return a plus

Junior T.J. Murphy returned to the lineup on March 20 against Davenport Univ. after missing eight contests with a bad hamstring. The North Olmstead, Ohio, native adds more speed and

Murphy is now batting .333 with two doubles and eight runs scored in 39 at-bats this season.

Tidbits

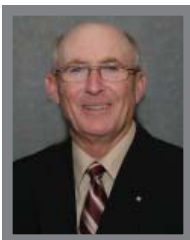

Woody Hunt

Head Coach • Belmont Univ./1980 • 29th Season • 1,251-520-3 (.706) overall



Cumberland University owes a great debt of gratitude to legendary and Hall of Fame head coach Woody Hunt for his great service not only to the baseball program but also to the athletic department and the University as well as the community of Lebanon.

Hunt begins his 28th season as head coach of the Bulldogs in 2009 and his 31st with the Cumberland program. He has amassed an impressive resume along the way and continues to add to his credentials with each passing year.

But even more importantly Hunt continues to play a major role within the overall landscape of the University as well as in the Lebanon and Wilson County communities where so many of his former players have settled into lives after baseball.

Hunt is one of only six coaches in history to register 1,000 career victories in the NAIA and heads into the '09 season with a 1,193-489-3 overall record. The Bulldogs have appeared in 10 NAIA World Series, including four in the last five seasons, but his most crowning program achievement came when CU claimed the 2004 national championship in Lewiston, Idaho. The Bulldogs have finished as the national runner-up on two other occasions, in 1995 and 2006.

Cumberland has won 16 conference championships during Hunt's tenure, including 10 in the Tennessee

Collegiate Athletic Conference (TCAC), five in the Mid-South Conference (MSC) and one in the TranSouth Conference (TSAC). CU has four district championships, 11 NAIA regional titles and has played in five super regionals as well.

The program has posted 20 seasons with 40 or more victories, including 16 of the last 17 years, while registering 50 or more wins seven times, all in the last dozen seasons. The 2004 squad set the school-record for victories with 59.

The Bulldogs have produced 51 NAIA All-Americans, including Steve Green, the only three-time All-American in program history. Seventy-two of Hunt's former players have signed professional contracts.

The Bulldogs have posted a 311-120 record over the last six seasons with five NAIA World Series appearances, one runner-up finish and one national title.

Hunt has also achieved individual success in the awards category, claiming 16 Coach of the Year honors, including the 2006 Rawlings National Coach of the Year award. He is a seven-time Southeast Region Coach of the Year and has also been a finalist for the National Coach of the Year Award four times.

Perhaps his greatest achievement lies in the facilities in which his team plays, practices and dresses. Cumberland has one of the finest baseball facilities in the nation, second to none in the NAIA, with Ernest L. Stockton Field and its 500 chairback seats and state-of-the-art press box, the Benton Jennings Indoor Hitting Complex and the Jeanette C. Rudy Clubhouse.
