

Rendezvous Camp Rules (Nakanawa rules amended)

- Life jackets are required when in any boat or canoe on the lake.
- Do not drop cigarettes on the grounds or in the lake! Camp Nakanawa is a smoke-free facility. No smoking in the buildings.
- Tennis shoes only on the tennis courts.
- Please do not write on or in the cabins or buildings. It doesn't matter that someone did in the past- Camp Nakanawa is trying to clean up the structures and your help is most appreciated.
- The group is responsible for setting tables and cleaning tables after meals. Sponges are available by the sink. Please sweep around tables as needed.
- Please sweep cabin, close all windows, turn off lights and pick up trash before leaving on Sunday
- Place everything back where you found it. Leave all buildings neat and clean.
- A list of cabin assignments will be posted in the Wigwam. Please check in when you arrive (see schedule for check-in times). Please do not move mattresses and beds from cabin to cabin or place mattresses on the floor.
- No hair dryers or electric heaters allowed. The electrical system cannot handle the wattage required for small appliances. If you blow the fuse, you're on your own.
- Please remove trash bags from cans, tie securely, and leave outside cabin or piled by the flagpole outside of the Wigwam. Additional trash bags are available in the Wigwam.
- The dumpster behind the dining hall is for cardboard only.

Important:

The enjoyment of adult beverages is allowed, with consideration to your fellow camp guests. Absolutely no adult beverages are allowed while participating in a scheduled trip or activity. Excessive use of alcohol will not be tolerated and will result in you and your party being asked to pack up and leave.

NO ILLEGAL SUBSTANCE OF ANY KIND WILL BE TOLERATED. DO NOT BRING IT TO CAMP.
