Notes: Cumberland continues its current 11-game homestand with three games against Embry-Riddle Univ. The Eagles are coached by former Bulldogs Randy and Chuck Stegall. ERAU swept three games from the Bulldogs last season in Daytona Beach as part of CU's Spring Break trip, winning 3-1, 6-2 and 8-5.

Schaefer leads the way

Senior lefthander Shawn Schaefer has been dominant to say the least through his first three starts of the season. Schaefer has won all three outings, all against quality opponents (North Alabama, Missouri Baptist and Oklahoma City Univ.), allowing just three earned runs and only 12 hits in his three starts. Opponents are batting just .167 against the Pitt Meadows, British Columbia, native, and he has a 1.37 ERA in 19.2 innings of work, ranking second in the TranSouth Conference and 34th nationally. Schaefer has also won the TSAC Pitcher of the Week honor twice already this season.

Bulldogs like the long ball

Cumberland has used the long ball this season with great success, a major problem for the Bulldogs last season when they belted just 61 home runs as a team. CU already has 37 homers in 20 contests this year, including nine by Troy Frazier and eight from Kris Miller. Only two players reached double figures last season (Sam Kikla - 11, Matt Holliman - 10), but the Bulldogs could surpass that before conference play begins March 26-27 at Union Univ. Under head coach Woody Hunt, Cumberland has traditionally been a team that hits a lot of home runs, surpassing 90 six times since 2000 and hitting more than 100 home runs in a season nine times during Hunt's more than 25 years at the helm of the program.

Frazier finds his stroke

Senior Troy Frazier started the year very slowly, with only four hits in the first seven games of the season. He collected seven hits with a pair of home runs and 10 RBIs in doubleheader against Viterbo Univ. on February 28, helping the Louisville, Ky., native earn TranSouth Conference Player of the Week honors on March 1. Frazier

was hitless at St. Catharine College and in the first doubleheader at Oklahoma City Univ. but has since recorded 18 hits in his last 30 at-bats (.600) with seven home runs, 12 RBIs and 12 runs scored. The Univ. of Kentucky transfer had one home run in the Sunday twinbill at OCU, another at Oklahoma Christian and two more round-trippers at Oklahoma Baptist. He then hit a towering, tape-measure homer Friday versus Shawnee State, a ball that hit a car on the other side of the street behind the leftfield fence. Frazier also hit a missile into the pine trees in deep center in Saturday's second game, a ball that traveled more than 400 feet easily. He is batting .439 overall, second best on the club, with a team-high nine home runs. He ranks second on the squad with 24 RBIs and 24 runs scored as well.

Greener is Mr. Steady

Senior Matt Greener continues to provide the consistency at the plate the club hoped for last year when it signed the Palm Beach CC product. Greener has hit safely in 19 of the team's 20 games this season and has multiple hits in nine of those contests. The Jupiter, Fla., native collected seven hits in the four games against No. 3 Oklahoma City Univ., last week and has already surpassed his home run total of last season, collecting his fifth and sixth round-trippers of the year this past weekend against Shawnee State. Greener leads the Bulldogs with eight doubles and ranks third on the club in batting average (.426), home runs, RBIs (23) and runs scored (21).

Sprague gets another win

Senior Adam Sprague posted his third victory in four outings this season in an 11-7 triumph at No. 3 Oklahoma City Univ. The lefthander allowed seven runs, two earned, on 10 hits in

a complete game, striking out seven. Sprague was dominant in his first two starts of the season, striking out a career-best 10 and giving up three hits and no runs in six innings against the Univ. of St. Francis. He backed that up by allowing one earned run and eight hits in five innings versus Viterbo Univ. The Winter Park, Fla., native has a 1.42 ERA in 19.0 innings of work this season with 20 strikeouts, and opponents are batting .288. Sprague posted six victories in 15 outings last season for the Bulldogs, splitting his time between starting and relieving.

Karahalios finds the mark

Senior Brian Karahalios had little success last season for the Bulldogs (nine hits in 43 total at-bats), struggling to find a place in the lineup as well as hits in limited action. But the Jacksonville,

Fla., native has taken full advantage of expanded playing time so far this season, leading the Bulldogs with a .486 batting average in 16 contests with five doubles and 10 RBIs. He is 8-for-14 (.571) over his last five games with three doubles and three RBIs. Karahalios is still trying to find an everyday position, splitting time between first base and designated hitter with an occasional start behind the plate.

Setback for Post

Senior Robert Post was very sharp in his opening start of the season, tossing a three-hit shutout with six strikeouts against the Univ. of St. Francis. He was not as sharp in his second outing, giving up four unearned runs and seven hits in a victory over Viterbo Univ., but the Mt. Juliet, Tenn., native lasted just one inning against Oklahoma City

Univ. before leaving with an injury. He gave up three runs on three hits to No. 3 OCU, taking the loss in a 10-7 defeat. Post will miss his next start because of the injury but hopefully will return for next weekend's series against Davenport Univ. and certainly for the conference opener at Union Univ. on March 26-27.

Texan busts out

Newcomer Kris Miller found his stroke over the last two weeks, raising his batting average 116 points over the last 11 contests. The New Caney, Texas, native has done it primarily with the long ball, belting all eight of his home runs during that stretch with 20 RBIs and 16 runs scored. He hit a solo homer in the Saturday opener at Oklahoma City Univ. and started a four-game home run streak Sunday against the Stars, recording

round-trippers in both ends of the twinbill and then in a pair of games Tuesday, at Southern Nazarene and Oklahoma Christian. Miller backed that up with a three homer performance in this past Saturday's opener against Shawnee State, hitting two-run shots in the first and third innings and a three-run bomb in the sixth, a ball that nearly made it to the road in leftfield. He is currently batting .338 and leads the Bulldogs with 28 RBIs. Miller ranks second in home runs and tied for third in RBIs (21).

Wilkerson has power arm

Junior Aaron Wilkerson came with great credentials after striking out 103 batters in 78 innings of work last season at Panola CC. The righthander has certainly shown a power arm in the early going for the Bulldogs as well, registering 26 strikeouts in 19.1 innings of work, including a 12-strikeout performance two weekends ago at Oklahoma City Univ. The Waco, Texas, native allowed seven hits and just two earned runs in the contest, keeping the Stars at bay before the Bulldogs exploded for six runs in the seventh for the victory. He did not walk a batter against OCU as well. Wilkerson struck out seven in five innings in his first start of the year, against the Univ. of St. Francis, and six more in six innings versus Viterbo Univ. He is 2-1 on the season with a 2.33 ERA and a team-best 26 strikeouts.

Tidbits

Greg Appleton has hit safely in his last five contests, recording seven hits in 14 at-bats with three home runs and nine RBIs. Five of Appleton's 11 hits this season have been homers, including a two-run shot off the bench in Friday's victory over Shawnee State ... Catcher David Fanshawe

got a deserved day/game off Saturday versus Shawnee State. Fanshawe was the DH in the opener of the doubleheader and did not play in the second game after making 15 consecutive starts behind the plate over a span of just 14 days ... Sam Kikla had a tough day Saturday against Shawnee State, going 0-for-6 with a run scored in the doubleheader, including at least four line drives right at players. Kikla still leads the Bulldogs with 27 runs scored and has 10 extra-base hits and 21 RBIs in 20 contests ... Max Kautz entered last weekend's series against Shawnee State batting just .228 with 18 strikeouts through 16 games, not unlike the Palo Alto, Calif., native's start to the 2009 campaign when he batted just .281 through the first 21 games of the year. Kautz rebounded last year, posting a .458 batting average over the final 27 contests of the season. He may have found his stroke over the weekend as well, collecting four hits, a pair of walks and five runs scored in two games.

Schaefer named Pitcher of the Week

Senior Shawn Schaefer was named TranSouth Conference Pitcher of the Week March 8 after his work in a victory at third-ranked Oklahoma City Univ. The Pitt Meadows, British Columbia, native allowed two unearned runs and just six hits to the Stars while striking out eight. He won the TSAC Pitcher of the Week accolade on March 1 as well after shutting out Missouri Baptist.

Greener named Player of the Week

Senior Matt Greener was named the TranSouth Conference Player of the Week on February 22 by the league office after batting .636 in five games and helping the Bulldogs start the season by winning 4-of-5 outings. Greener went 7-for-11 in four starts with four runs scored, three doubles, two home runs and 10 RBIs. He also recorded a walk and stole a base. The Jupiter, Fla., native drove in a pair of runs in a 12-6 victory in CU's season opener at North Alabama. He doubled twice and drove in a run in the home opener against the Univ. of St. Francis and then registered six RBIs in the second game, hitting a solo homer and a grand slam in the same inning. Greener hit just four home runs and drove in 29 runs all of last season in 183 at-bats. He had at least one hit in all five games and at least one RBI in four of the five contests.

Schaefer named to All-Canadian Team

Cumberland's Shawn Schaefer was recently named to the CanadianBaseballNetwork.com All-Canadian College Team. The lefthander was an Honorable Mention selection and was the only player from the TranSouth Conference in the listings. Schaefer tossed 5.2 innings in CU's season-opening victory at North Alabama, allowing four runs on five hits with one walk and three strikeouts. Last season the Pitt Meadows, British Columbia, native was the anchor of the Bulldogs staff, working a team-high 88.0 innings and posting a 6-3 record with a 4.40 ERA. He struck out 69 in 13 appearances, registering seven complete games. Just two other players from the Mid-South Conference were on the list – Marc Wilson from Campbellsville Univ. Woody Hunt

Head Coach • Belmont Univ./1980 • 29th Season • 1,241-518-3 (.705) overall



Cumberland University owes a great debt of gratitude to legendary and Hall of Fame head coach Woody Hunt for his great service not only to the baseball program but also to the athletic department and the University as well as the community of Lebanon.

Hunt begins his 28th season as head coach of the Bulldogs in 2009 and his 31st with the Cumberland program. He has amassed an impressive resume along the way and continues to add to his credentials with each passing year.

But even more importantly Hunt continues to play a major role within the overall landscape of the University as well as in the Lebanon and Wilson County communities where so many of his former players have settled into lives after baseball.

Hunt is one of only six coaches in history to register 1,000 career victories in the NAIA and heads into the '09 season with a 1,193-489-3 overall record. The Bulldogs have appeared in 10 NAIA World Series, including four in the last five seasons, but his most crowning program achievement came when CU claimed the 2004 national championship in Lewiston, Idaho. The Bulldogs have finished as the national runner-up on two other occasions, in 1995 and 2006.

Cumberland has won 16 conference championships during Hunt's tenure, including 10 in the Tennessee

Collegiate Athletic Conference (TCAC), five in the Mid-South Conference (MSC) and one in the TranSouth Conference (TSAC). CU has four district championships, 11 NAIA regional titles and has played in five super regionals as well.

The program has posted 20 seasons with 40 or more victories, including 16 of the last 17 years, while registering 50 or more wins seven times, all in the last dozen seasons. The 2004 squad set the school-record for victories with 59.

The Bulldogs have produced 51 NAIA All-Americans, including Steve Green, the only three-time All-American in program history. Seventy-two of Hunt's former players have signed professional contracts.

The Bulldogs have posted a 311-120 record over the last six seasons with five NAIA World Series appearances, one runner-up finish and one national title.

Hunt has also achieved individual success in the awards category, claiming 16 Coach of the Year honors, including the 2006 Rawlings National Coach of the Year award. He is a seven-time Southeast Region Coach of the Year and has also been a finalist for the National Coach of the Year Award four times.

Perhaps his greatest achievement lies in the facilities in which his team plays, practices and dresses. Cumberland has one of the finest baseball facilities in the nation, second to none in the NAIA, with Ernest L. Stockton Field and its 500 chairback seats and state-of-the-art press box, the Benton Jennings Indoor Hitting Complex and the Jeanette C. Rudy Clubhouse.
