Special Tournament Notes

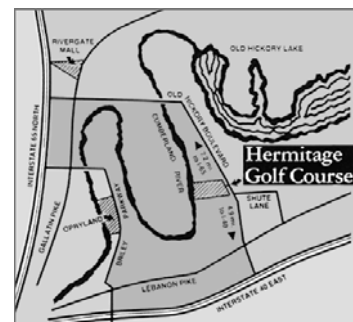
- A scramble format will be used again this year to speed up play and add to the fun. Captain's choice will determine the play of the ball.
