The Bulldogs swept Union last season at home during the regular season (4-2, 5-3, 7-1) but lost a 5-4 decision in Jackson, eliminating CU from the TranSouth Championships ... Cumberland is 16-7 over the last six years against Union, including 6-3 at Fesmire Field. CU has swept the regular season series in three of the last six seasons -- 2005, 2006 and 2009.

Schaefer named NAIA Player of the Week

Senior Shawn Schaefer was named the NAIA National Pitcher of the Week on Tuesday after posting a pair of complete game victories on the mound, including a four-hitter against sixth-ranked Embry-Riddle. The lefthander struck out a season-high 12, walked just one and worked all nine innings in a 3-1 triumph over the Eagles. The Pitt Meadows, British Columbia, native then tossed his second one-hitter of the season, allowing a leadoff single and then retiring the next 15 batters in an 11-0, five-inning victory over Davenport Univ. on Saturday. Schaefer has won all five of his starts this season, posting a 1.07 ERA in 33.2 innings with 32 strikeouts and just six walks. Opponents are batting just .143 against him as well. He earned the TranSouth Pitcher of the Week honor on Monday this week as well as on March 1 and March 8 this season previously. Schaefer is the third Bulldog player to win NAIA National Player of the Week honors, joining Jeff Luttrell (1993) and Angel Murcado (2006).

Greener putting up incredible numbers

Senior Matt Greener has continued his assault on opposing pitchers throughout this season, posting monstrous numbers along the way. The Jupiter, Fla., native leads the Bulldogs with a .485 batting average with 11 doubles, 11 home runs and 45 RBIs and has 48 total hits. He ranks in the Top 20 nationally in five categories, tying for first in total home runs and RBIs and ranking third in slugging percentage (.929), fourth in hits and 17th in batting average. He has hit safely in 27 of the team's 28 contests and has 15 multi-hit and 10 multi-RBI games this season. The Palm Beach CC transfer is also on a career-long 16-game hitting streak, batting .516 (32-for-62) during the stretch with seven doubles, eight home runs and 30 RBIs. Greener has been even more

ridiculous over the last seven outings, collecting 18 hits in 27 at-bats (.667) with five home runs and 20 RBIs.

Greener, Schaefer earn TranSouth honors

Seniors Matt Greener and Shawn Schaefer were named TranSouth Player and Pitcher of the Week, respectively, on Monday by the conference office. The honor is the third this season for Schaefer and the second for Greener. Schaefer won a pair of games last week, tossing two complete games, including a four-hit gem against sixth-ranked Embry-Riddle on March 15. The lefthander struck out a season-high 12, walked just one and worked all nine innings in a 3-1 triumph over the Eagles. The Pitt Meadows, British Columbia, native then tossed his second one-hitter of the season, allowing a leadoff single and then retiring the next 15 batters in an 11-0, five-inning victory over Davenport Univ. Schaefer has won all five of his starts this season, posting a 1.07 ERA in 33.2 innings with 32 strikeouts and just six walks. Opponents are batting just .143 against him as well. He earned the TranSouth Pitcher of the Week honors on March 1 and March 8 this season previously. Greener batted .571 (12-for-21) in six games with two doubles, three home runs and 13 RBIs as well as six runs scored. He collected five hits, scored a pair of runs and drove in three others, as the Bulldogs won 2-of-3 versus Embry-Riddle. The Jupiter, Fla., native added a two-run homer in CU's 17-7 triumph over Georgetown College, and then hit a pair of home runs – a three-run shot and a two-run homer – in a doubleheader sweep of Davenport Univ.

Frazier stays steady

Senior Troy Frazier has become perhaps the steadiest performer for the Bulldogs this season

outside of Matt Greener. Frazier is batting .418 overall, second best among regulars, with 10 home runs, 30 RBIs and 32 runs scored. He ranks second on the club in homers and runs scored and third in RBIs while batting third everyday and playing centerfield in all but three games this season. He was on a torrid pace for six games during the trip to Oklahoma for Spring Break, posting 16 hits in the six contests. He has cooled a bit since but still is batting .400 (14-for-35) over the last nine games with seven RBIs and nine runs scored. He and Sam Kikla have been setting the table for Kris Miller and Greener, the top RBI men on the club.

Wilkerson matches Schaefer versus ERAU

With the injury to senior Robert Post, junior Aaron Wilkerson has stepped into the vacant spot in the

rotation and been superb, defeating third-ranked Oklahoma City Univ. and No. 6 Embry-Riddle in his last two starts. Both were superior efforts, striking out 12 at OCU and giving up just three hits with nine strikeouts versus ERAU. The righthander lowered his ERA to 2.05 in 26.1 innings of work with 35 strikeouts and just five walks while allowing only 20 hits.

Kikla a stat-sheet stuffer

ESPN's Dick Vitale coined the phrase stat-sheet stuffer for basketball players who register in multiple statistical categories. Bulldog senior Sam Kikla fits the bill on the baseball field after leading the club in nine offensive categories last season. The Malabar, Fla., native has kept up the good work this season as well, though he has a lot more help offensively this season.

Kikla is batting .366 and leads the Bulldogs with 39 runs scored. He is also tied for the team lead with 16 walks. He has also been hit eight times and has a .496 on-base percentage, third best on the squad. Kikla has added five doubles, seven home runs and 29 RBIs and ranks second on the team with six stolen bases. After going through an eight-game stretch with just four hits in 27 at-bats (.148), he has rebounded with 12 hits in his last 25 at-bats (.480) over seven outings with eight RBIs and 11 runs scored.

Post should get Saturday start

Senior Robert Post returned to the mound on Tuesday for the first time in 17 days, tossing one inning of hitless relief with one strikeout against eighth-ranked Campbellsville Univ. The righthander tossed just one inning at Oklahoma

City Univ. on March 6 before leaving with an injury. The Mt. Juliet, Tenn., native was very sharp in his opening start of the season, tossing a three-hit shutout with six strikeouts against the Univ. of St. Francis. He was not as sharp in his second outing, giving up four unearned runs and seven hits in a victory over Viterbo Univ. before running into trouble against the Stars, giving up three runs on three hits to OCU and taking the loss in a 10-7 defeat. For the season Post is 2-1 with a 1.20 ERA with 12 strikeouts in 15.0 innings of work.

Miller keeps up with Greener, Frazier

Senior Kris Miller has found himself in a very enviable position this season, batting in the cleanup spot between Troy Frazier and Matt Greener, the team's top hitters through the first half of the year. Miller has seen a lot of fastballs because of Frazier and Greener's success, and has capitalized. Miller is batting .376 with 10 doubles, nine home runs, 33 RBIs and 31 runs scored, ranking in the Top 3 on the club in all five categories among everyday players. He has been especially hot over the last 11 games, batting .514 (19-for-37) with six doubles, four home runs, 14 RBIs and 15 runs scored. He also has eight of his 13 walks during the stretch and only has 11 strikeouts for the entire year.

Fanshawe really cold

Junior David Fanshawe has done a superb job behind the plate this season for the Bulldogs, helping the pitching staff post a 3.33 ERA with 181 strikeouts and just 58 walks through 203.0 innings of work. The Miami, Fla., native has also been a big contributor with the bat through the first 22 games of the year, batting .375 with five

doubles and 13 RBIs as well as eight walks. But Fanshawe has been ice cold at the plate over the last six contests, going 3-for-23 (.130) with one double, two RBIs and three walks. More disturbing is his penchant for striking out, which he has done eight times during the stretch after registering just nine strikeouts through the first 22 games.

Team Nuggets

Cumberland has scored in the first inning in 18 of the team's 28 contests this season, netting 41 runs. The Bulldogs have outscored their opponents 121-66 in the first three innings this season ... Cumberland is 18-0 this year when leading after six innings, a tribute to the starters and their ability to finish games and also to a good relief staff that has posted a 4-1 record with five saves and a 2.08 ERA ... Cumberland has scored in double figures 11 times this season, posting an 10-1 record in those games, and has posted double-digit hits in 16 contests, going 14-2 in those outings ... Cumberland pitchers have 12 complete games so far in 2010 and have allowed two runs or fewer in 12 contests. The Bulldogs have also given up seven hits or less in a game 13 times this season.

Tidbits

Greg Appleton heads into the weekend with just four hits in his last 16 at-bats (.250) over the last seven games. The Port Coquitlam, British Columbia, native has scored seven runs in the seven contests, drawing six walks and one hit batsman ... Junior T.J. Murphy returned to the lineup last weekend against Davenport Univ. after missing eight contests with a bad hamstring. He went 0-for-1 with a walk against DU and started

Woody Hunt

Head Coach • Belmont Univ./1980 • 29th Season • 1,249-519-3 (.706) overall



Cumberland University owes a great debt of gratitude to legendary and Hall of Fame head coach Woody Hunt for his great service not only to the baseball program but also to the athletic department and the University as well as the community of Lebanon.

Hunt begins his 28th season as head coach of the Bulldogs in 2009 and his 31st with the Cumberland program. He has amassed an impressive resume along the way and continues to add to his credentials with each passing year.

But even more importantly Hunt continues to play a major role within the overall landscape of the University as well as in the Lebanon and Wilson County communities where so many of his former players have settled into lives after baseball.

Hunt is one of only six coaches in history to register 1,000 career victories in the NAIA and heads into the '09 season with a 1,193-489-3 overall record. The Bulldogs have appeared in 10 NAIA World Series, including four in the last five seasons, but his most crowning program achievement came when CU claimed the 2004 national championship in Lewiston, Idaho. The Bulldogs have finished as the national runner-up on two other occasions, in 1995 and 2006.

Cumberland has won 16 conference championships during Hunt's tenure, including 10 in the Tennessee

Collegiate Athletic Conference (TCAC), five in the Mid-South Conference (MSC) and one in the TranSouth Conference (TSAC). CU has four district championships, 11 NAIA regional titles and has played in five super regionals as well.

The program has posted 20 seasons with 40 or more victories, including 16 of the last 17 years, while registering 50 or more wins seven times, all in the last dozen seasons. The 2004 squad set the school-record for victories with 59.

The Bulldogs have produced 51 NAIA All-Americans, including Steve Green, the only three-time All-American in program history. Seventy-two of Hunt's former players have signed professional contracts.

The Bulldogs have posted a 311-120 record over the last six seasons with five NAIA World Series appearances, one runner-up finish and one national title.

Hunt has also achieved individual success in the awards category, claiming 16 Coach of the Year honors, including the 2006 Rawlings National Coach of the Year award. He is a seven-time Southeast Region Coach of the Year and has also been a finalist for the National Coach of the Year Award four times.

Perhaps his greatest achievement lies in the facilities in which his team plays, practices and dresses. Cumberland has one of the finest baseball facilities in the nation, second to none in the NAIA, with Ernest L. Stockton Field and its 500 chairback seats and state-of-the-art press box, the Benton Jennings Indoor Hitting Complex and the Jeanette C. Rudy Clubhouse.
