### CU takes on old rival Martin Methodist

Cumberland faces an old rival from as far back as its junior college days, taking on Martin Methodist at Ernest L. Stockton Field. The Bulldogs and Redhawks have played 28 times over the last seven seasons, with CU holding a 21-7 edge in the series. The Bulldogs have won the conference series in each of the last six campaigns, including three-game sweeps in 2005 and 2006. The clubs have also played in the TranSouth Championships in 2003 (one win for each team), 2004 (1 CU victory) and 2008 (2 CU wins), and the Region XI Tournament in 2003 (one CU win) and 2004 (2 CU victories).

### Bulldog pitching staff lays a big egg

Cumberland's pitching staff had been the most consistent aspect to this year's rather inconsistent club, but the staff as a whole, and particularly the bullpen, laid a huge egg last weekend at Freed-Hardeman. The staff posted an ERA of 9.97 in the three games, allowing 40 hits and 10 home runs in 21.2 innings of work. The bullpen was especially horrendous, giving up 18 hits and six homers in 4.2 innings with an ERA of 25.07, and that includes a scoreless inning tossed by Richard Timbrook when he picked up the save in CU's only victory of the series. The Bulldog defense did not help matters as well, committing eight errors in the three contests, including five in Saturday's finale.

### Kikla has big week

Junior Sam Kikla enjoyed quite a stretch of four games last week for CU, going 8-for-16 (.500) with five runs scored and nine RBIs. The junior hit safely in all four contests and currently has a six-game hitting streak. He singled and scored in a midweek contest at Lee University. In the first game of Saturday's doubleheader at Freed-Hardeman, Kikla went 5-for-5 with four runs scored, a double, two home runs and eight RBIs. He hit a two-run homer in the first, drove in a run with a sacrifice fly in the third, singled home a run in the fifth and hit a three-run homer in the sixth. He also doubled home a run in the eighth in the Bulldogs victory. The Malabar, Fla., native was 7-for-11 in the series at FHU with four extra-base hits, four runs scored and nine RBIs. For the season Kikla leads the Bulldogs with 57 hits, 10 home runs, 42 RBIs, 40 runs scored, 98 total bases and seven stolen bases. He ranks fourth in batting average at .363.

### Kautz continues to swing hot bat

As hot as Sam Kikla was last week, junior Max Kautz has been tremendous at the plate over the five weeks, batting .446 (25-for-56) in 15 contests with five doubles, three home runs, 12 RBIs and

18 runs scored. He has also drawn six walks and been hit four times, reaching base in 35 of his 70 plate appearances during the stretch. Kautz started the season slowly, batting .286 in 28 at-bats in the first 20 games of the season. During his current hot streak the Palo Alto, Calif., native has posted 12 multi-hit and eight multi-run games. He missed three games in the middle of April because of an infection in his foot but returned to the lineup at Lambuth two weekends ago and has since batted .464 (13-for-28) with eight runs scored in seven outings, including a three-hit contest at 11th-ranked Lee University on April 21 and a three-hit game in the opener at Freed-Hardeman. Kautz has hit safely in 16 of his last 18 contests. For the season Kautz is batting a team-leading .396 with six doubles, four home runs, 18 RBIs and 30 runs scored in just 32 games.

**Fisher keeps finding holes**

Sophomore Tyler Fisher's swing isn't necessarily the most fluid, but he continues to find the holes for hits, putting together a current 11-game hitting streak, third longest on the club this season. The Kokomo, Ind., native has hit .378 (14-for-27) during the stretch with two doubles, eight walks, 10 runs scored and 13 RBIs. He hit his third grand slam of the season last weekend at Freed-Hardeman. Fisher has just one hit in eight of the 11 outings but has reached base in 23 of his 47 plate appearances during the 11 games. He has hit safely in 23 of his last 25 contests over the last five weeks, raising his average more than 160 points to the current .341. He also has 10 doubles, five home runs, 37 RBIs and 23 runs scored. He has played all three outfield positions and has just one error in 65 chances this season.

**Greener finds longball stroke**

Junior Matt Greener had a seven-game hitting streak come to an end in last Saturday's second game at Freed-Hardeman, but the utility player was 14-for-28 (.500) over the seven-game stretch with five extra-base hits with six runs scored and eight RBIs. He doubled twice at FHU and hit a pair of home runs the weekend before at Lambuth. Greener is batting .384 (33-for-86) over the last five weeks with eight doubles, 17 RBIs and 17 runs scored. He has hit safely in 21 of the past 25 outings. For the season he is batting .371, third best on the club, and ranks second on the club with 56 hits. He also has 11 doubles, 27 RBIs and 26 runs scored while making starts at five different positions.

**Schaefer stays strong in opener**

Despite last weekend's meltdown by the pitching staff, junior Shawn Schaefer had another strong out-

ing in the opener Friday, allowing three earned runs on seven hits in eight innings of work. The lefthander walked four and struck out four and left the game with a 6-4 advantage. CU eventually lost, 7-6, but the lefthander has now worked at least six innings in seven of his eight starts this season, including a pair of nine-inning outings and one 10-inning affair. The Pitt Meadows, British Columbia, native is 4-2 this season in 65.0 innings with 49 strikeouts, a 4.15 ERA and a .248 opponent batting average. His one hiccup this season came at Lyon College, where he allowed nine runs on 12 hits in five innings. In his other seven starts, Schaefer has a 2.73 ERA in 56.0 innings of work with 40 strikeouts and a .202 opponent batting average. The Bulldogs may only be 4-7 on Fridays this season, but it's not because of the pitching of Mr. Schaefer. He ranks 16th nationally in innings pitched this season. He also ranks 10th in the TranSouth in ERA and ninth in opponent batting average.

### Post slightly injured in start

Junior Robert Post had his shortest outing of the season last weekend at Freed-Hardeman after suffering a slight injury in the first inning of Saturday's opener. The righthander did make it through the fourth inning and was in line for the victory, leaving the game with the Bulldogs leading 13-2. The Mt. Juliet, Tenn., native allowed two runs on four hits, walking four and striking out four and raising his ERA to 1.81. Post has worked at least five innings in his previous nine starts and into the sixth in all but one game that was ended because of the 10-run rule. He has six quality starts this season (6.0 innings of more, three or fewer runs allowed) and he allowed just three earned runs combined in his two defeats in 2009, a 3-1 loss at Embry-Riddle and a 4-2 defeat to Bethel College. For the season post is now 5-2 with a 1.81 ERA in 59.2 innings of work with 57 strikeouts and a .167 opponent batting average. He ranks second nationally in opponent batting average and hits allowed per game (5.13) and is 10th in the country in ERA, 20th in earned runs allowed (1.30) and 49th in innings pitched. Post is third in the TranSouth in ERA and leads in the league in opponent batting average.

### Timbrook in a tough spot

Senior Richard Timbrook helped the Bulldog bullpen greatly in last weekend's Saturday opener at Freed-Hardeman, coming on in the eighth inning to get a save despite giving up two hits and walking a batter. The righthander then started game two of the twinbill but did not fare as well, having his worst outing of the season, giving up 11 runs, six earned, on 11 hits in five innings. He picked up the loss, ending his eight-game winning streak as well. Timbrook has been perhaps the team's most consistent hurler, working at least six innings in six of his last seven starts until this past weekend and posting six quality starts during the stretch. The Independence, Mo.,

native has worked a team-high 65.2 innings this season, posting an 8-2 record with a 3.43 ERA, 37 strikeouts and a .275 opponent batting average. He ranks sixth in the TranSouth in ERA and 14th in opponent batting average.

### Pitching still leads the way for CU

Despite last weekend's near collapse as a staff, Bulldog pitching has been the team's most consistent group this season, especially considering more than 90 percent of the team's innings did not return in 2009. The staff ranks in the Top 35 nationally in five categories, including 28th in hits allowed (7.43) and opponent batting average (.268), 32nd in walks allowed (2.53) and earned runs (3.61) and 33rd in earned-run-average (4.55). The unit also ranks 42nd in the country in runs allowed per game (4.90). In the team's 28 victories this season, the staff ERA is a fantastic 2.70 with 153 strikeouts in 207.0 innings and a .237 opponent batting average. On the flipside, in the club's 21 losses the pitchers have posted a 7.11 ERA in 143.0 innings with a .309 opponent batting average. The Bulldog defense also helps out, ranking 31st nationally in fielding percentage.

### Tidbits

Cumberland has used a different starting lineup in each game this season and has used 36 different players in 2009 because of injuries and suspensions ... Clint Alexander has hit .356 (16-for-45) over the last 15 games (13 starts) with four doubles, eight RBIs and nine runs scored. He has raised his batting average 76 points during that stretch to its current .265. The Murfreesboro, Tenn., native is 7-for-18 (.389) with four runs scored and three RBIs over his last five starts ... Kyle West has started behind the plate in 16 of the 18 games in the month of April for the Bulldogs ... Matt Holliman has just six hits in 32 at-bats (.188) over his last 10 games. He does have six walks and seven runs scored during the stretch, but is just 3-for-17 (.176) over the last five games ... Eric Mull went 4-for-10 (.400) in four games last week, scoring three runs and raising his average 19 points to its current .228.

### Kikla, Sprague named TSAC Player, Pitcher of the Week

Juniors Sam Kikla and Adam Sprague were named the TranSouth Player and Pitcher of the Week, respectively, on April 13 for their performances in last week's victories over ninth-ranked Campbellsville and No. 18 Trevecca. Sprague and TNU's Wesley Griggs shared the Pitcher of the Week honors. Kikla helped the Bulldogs to a 3-1 mark for the week, including a 19-8 victory over Campbellsville and a series win against Trevecca. The junior infielder belted four home runs during the week, with a pair versus Campbellsville. He also hit a two-run walkout shot in a 7-5, 11-inning triumph in the opening game of a doubleheader Saturday against Trevecca and

added a three-run homer in the second game that proved to be the decisive runs. For the week the Malabar, Fla., native was 7-for-18 (.389) with five runs scored, four home runs, 10 RBIs and a walk with a slugging percentage of 1.056. Sprague also played a big role in CU's doubleheader sweep of the Trojans on Saturday, picking up a win and a save in the twinbill. The Winter Park, Fla., native tossed 3.2 hitless innings of relief in the opener to earn the victory after Kikla's walk-off home run. He retired 11 of the 12 batters he faced. In the second game Sprague struck out Brian Dirheimer, the potential winning run, with two runners on in the eighth, and recorded two more strikeouts in the ninth to post his first save of the season.

**Kautz, Post selected TSAC POW**

Juniors Max Kautz and Robert Post were selected the TranSouth Conference Player and Pitcher of the Week, respectively, March 29 as named by the conference office. Kautz hit .563 during CU's four victories with nine runs scored, three doubles, one home run and five RBIs. He also drew two walks while posting a .938 slugging percentage. The Palo Alto, Calif., native posted at least two hits in all four games for the week. Kautz hit a game-winning two-run homer in the 10-inning, 11-10 victory over Lyon College in the first game of a doubleheader. Post posted a five-inning no-hitter in his only appearance of the week. The Mt. Juliet, Tenn., native struck out eight and walked three against Lyon in the no-hitter and allowed just an unearned run on a throwing error in the contest.

**Sprague voted TSAC Pitcher of the Week**

Junior Adam Sprague was voted the TranSouth Conference Pitcher of the Week on February 23 after posting his second victory of the season, versus Iowa Wesleyan. The lefthander from Winter Park, Fla., tossed six innings, allowing just two earned runs, striking out six and walking two against the Tigers.

**CU ranked 11th in preseason**

The Cumberland baseball team ranked 11th in the 2009 NAIA Baseball Coaches' Preseason Top 25 Poll announced in November. The Bulldogs posted a 46-21 record last season and finished the year one win shy of their fifth straight NAIA World Series appearance. The Bulldogs and 28th-year head coach Woody Hunt returned four starters from last year's club, including catcher Mike Wheeler, who hit 15 home runs and had 64 RBIs, as well as outfielder/DH Zack Diekmann, who belted eight home runs with 26 RBIs. CU had to replace almost its entire pitching staff that posted a team earned-run-average of 3.74 last season and allowed opponents to bat just .258. Gone from roster are eight pitchers who accounted for 75 percent of last season's innings.

**Hunt elected to Tennessee Sports Hall of Fame**

Cumberland baseball coach Woody Hunt was one of 11 greats inducted into the Tennessee Sports Hall of Fame on February 20 at the Renaissance Hotel in Nashville, Tenn. Others who were inducted include Sam Bartholomew, Jr., Philip Hutcheson, Joe Gilliam, Jr. (posthumous), Tommy Owen (posthumous), Andy Nelson, Sarah Ingram, Elliot Perry, Tim Priest, Stan Huntsman and Chip Kell. Hunt has served on the baseball staff at Cumberland for 30 years, three as an assistant in 1978, '79 and '81 and then as the head coach since 1982. CU was a two-year school his first two seasons and became a four-year institution beginning with the 1984 baseball season. The Belmont University graduate has compiled 1,193 victories in 27 seasons as head coach at CU and an 1,132-463-3 mark as head coach since 1984. He is one of only six coaches to register more than 1,000 career victories in NAIA. It marked the fifth Hall of Fame in which Hunt was inducted. He had previously been inducted into the NAIA, Cumberland, Boyle County [KY] and Tennessee Baseball Coaches Association Halls of Fame.

**CU picked to win TranSouth**

Cumberland's baseball team was picked to win the TranSouth Conference in a preseason poll of the league coaches announced in January by the conference office. Cumberland received six of the eight first-place votes in a poll of the league coaches and tallied 62 total points. Trevecca received the other two first-place votes and had 58 total points for second place. Union University, Martin Methodist and Lyon College ranked third, fourth and fifth, respectively, with Freed-Hardeman, Bethel College and Mid-Continent rounding out the poll. In 2008, Trevecca won the regular season title, with Cumberland taking the TranSouth Tournament championship. The Bulldogs won their fifth straight Region XI Tournament but fell one game shy of the NAIA World Series, losing in a best-of-three series to Union College (KY).

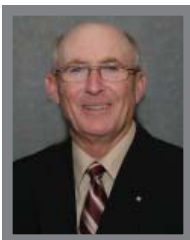

# Woody Hunt

Head Coach • Belmont Univ./1980 • 28th Season • 1,221-510-3 (.705) overall



Cumberland University owes a great debt of gratitude to legendary and Hall of Fame head coach Woody Hunt for his great service not only to the baseball program but also to the athletic department and the University as well as the community of Lebanon.

Hunt begins his 28th season as head coach of the Bulldogs in 2009 and his 31st with the Cumberland program. He has amassed an impressive resume along the way and continues to add to his credentials with each passing year.

But even more importantly Hunt continues to play a major role within the overall landscape of the University as well as in the Lebanon and Wilson County communities where so many of his former players have settled into lives after baseball.

Hunt is one of only six coaches in history to register 1,000 career victories in the NAIA and heads into the '09 season with a 1,193-489-3 overall record. The Bulldogs have appeared in 10 NAIA World Series, including four in the last five seasons, but his most crowning program achievement came when CU claimed the 2004 national championship in Lewiston, Idaho. The Bulldogs have finished as the national runner-up on two other occasions, in 1995 and 2006.

Cumberland has won 16 conference championships during Hunt's tenure, including 10 in the Tennessee

Collegiate Athletic Conference (TCAC), five in the Mid-South Conference (MSC) and one in the TransSouth Conference (TSAC). CU has four district championships, 11 NAIA regional titles and has played in five super regionals as well.

The program has posted 20 seasons with 40 or more victories, including 16 of the last 17 years, while registering 50 or more wins seven times, all in the last dozen seasons. The 2004 squad set the school-record for victories with 59.

The Bulldogs have produced 51 NAIA All-Americans, including Steve Green, the only three-time All-American in program history. Seventy-two of Hunt's former players have signed professional contracts.

The Bulldogs have posted a 311-120 record over the last six seasons with five NAIA World Series appearances, one runner-up finish and one national title.

Hunt has also achieved individual success in the awards category, claiming 16 Coach of the Year honors, including the 2006 Rawlings National Coach of the Year award. He is a seven-time Southeast Region Coach of the Year and has also been a finalist for the National Coach of the Year Award four times.

Perhaps his greatest achievement lies in the facilities in which his team plays, practices and dresses. Cumberland has one of the finest baseball facilities in the nation, second to none in the NAIA, with Ernest L. Stockton Field and its 500 chairback seats and state-of-the-art press box, the Benton Jennings Indoor Hitting Complex and the Jeanette C. Rudy Clubhouse.
