RAIN Parent's Attending Narcotics Anonymous Meetings

The **RAIN Project Transitional Living Center** is on Lewis Road near CSUCI. It provides housing, and necessary training and resources, to help individuals and families successfully transition to independent living. Besides being a cooperative effort on the parts of several different County agencies and departments, cities throughout Ventura County, and many churches and community groups as well as individuals pitch in to meet the wide range of needs of the homeless population.

The RAIN center has served over 1000 individuals, half of whom are children since November of 1997. They continue on their mission to "end homelessness, one person at a time."

For much of this year **Dana Little** has been volunteering her time on Wednesday evenings, to baby sit the children of parents attending NA meetings. Starting this week, and additional 10 mothers and their children from the RAIN Center will be attending the Wednesday evening NA meetings here at the

church. **Dana** and **Matthew Malloy** have committed to being here to watch the children. Some of these boys and girls face their own exceptional challenges as a result of inherited addiction, and the difficult life experiences they have endured.

So these kids require more supervision and attention than most kids do, and Dana and Matt could certainly use more help. Parents and children begin to arrive at the church about 6:45pm, and the NA meeting ends at 8pm. So the time commitment isn't that long.
