This year Ms. Kelley will not be working in summer camp except to drive the bus on Wednesdays and to do a 2 week Musical/Drama camp.

Lunches

There will be no hot lunches this summer. Everyone will need to bring lunch everyday. If I can make other arrangements for hot lunches before summer camp, I will notify you, but for now there will be packed lunches from home only.

Sports Camps

Sports Camps are separate from Wildcat Summer Camp. They are not part of the summer camp program. The coaches plan these completely. If you sign your child up for any sports camp, you must be responsible for getting your child to and from camp. We will not be staffed to do it this year because of budget cuts. Also, any child attending a sports camp will not be eligible to go on the field trip that week. Last year was very difficult with children going to many different activities at the same time.

In the event I am able to provide hot lunches to summer camp, sports camp children will need to bring their lunches that week. We will not bring any lunches out of the cafeteria for sports camp children like we did last year. This is a health department issue.

Arrival Times

All classes start at 9:00 am sharp. All children need to be here by 9:00 am to participate in all the activities. Also, if we have any extra teachers we will send them home at 10:00 am. In order to stay in compliance with our state licensing regulations, we will not accept children after 10:00 am.

Three Strikes Policy

Strikes will be given to a child when:

1. Hurting other children –
hitting, kicking, pushing, biting etc.
2. Destroying property –
the schools or someone else's
3. Disrespecting teachers –
arguing, talking back, aggression of any kind

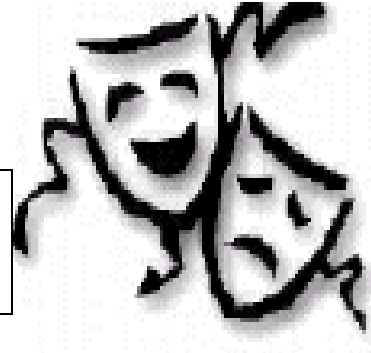

Mrs. Cook and Ms. Lindsey are proud to announce their 3rd annual week-long musical theatre camp open to all rising 5th grade through rising 8th grade students. This week is designed to teach students basic skills in musical theatre through participating in a Broadway Junior Musical. It will be an intense and fun week from auditioning to rehearsing with choreography and it will culminate in a performance on Friday evening (12th) at the conclusion of the week. High School choir and theatre students will be involved in working the camp and assisting Mrs. Cook and Ms. Lindsey while earning a percentage of the camp proceeds for their festival trip next school year. We look forward to working with a fun and exciting group of students for this week and know that all of the students involved will benefit from the experience.

The camp will be **June 8-12, in the lecture hall from 8:00am - 3:00pm, with Friday being all day until after the performance Friday night.** Students will need to bring a sack lunch and extra water each day. No sandals, flip-flops, etc. The cost of the camp is \$250, which includes a snack and drink each day, dinner on performance day and 2 tickets per family to see the show. You will need to submit a \$100 non-refundable deposit by February 28th to reserve a spot for your child.

Study Skills Workshop

Description:

This week long workshop is a study skills program designed to help students learn how to study. The goal is to motivate students to learn at their potential. Good study habits will help your child achieve this goal. Learning how to study is too important to be left to chance or an occasional reference in a textbook. The curriculum for this course is called **Study Right**.

Study Right was written for Christian schools. Each study skill includes biblical principles that reinforce the need for learning how to study. Biblical integration is the incorporation of Scripture and Biblical principles into classroom material. The **Study Right** lesson plans include Biblical integration suggestions throughout each lesson.

Topics to be covered include the following:

- Managing self and time
- Listening and participating in class
- Reading textbooks
- Taking notes
- Preparing for tests and taking tests.

Description
