- Choose Library <http://www.bethelu.edu/library/>

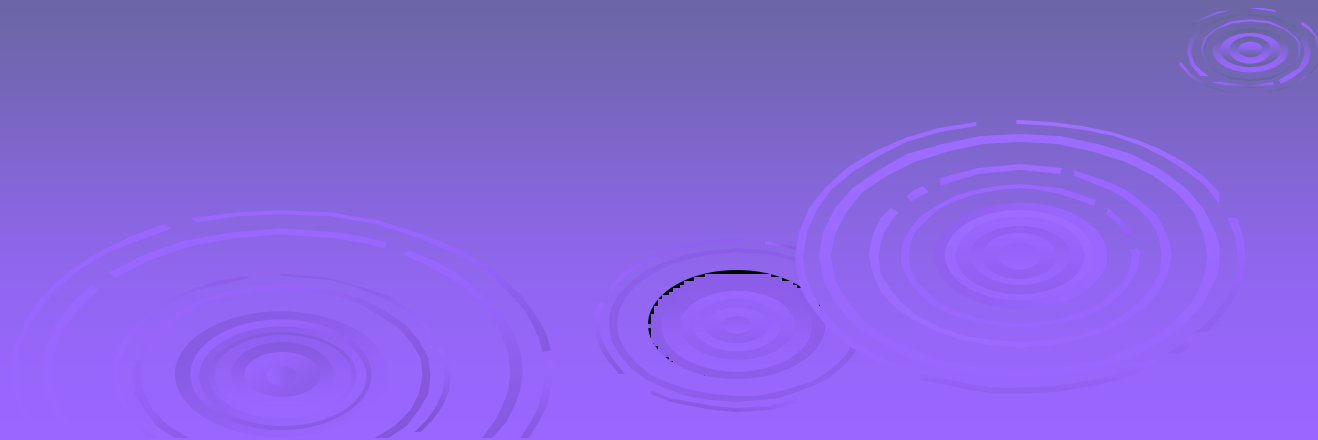
Choose Electronic Resources

- Choose Browse by Subject (Example: Business)
- Choose Academic Search Premier (as an example)
- Enter your Login/Password combination. This is your Bethel Login name and email password (all lower case).

Continue.....


- When the Big Blue Button comes up, Choose Ebscohost
- Choose Academic Search Premier again –Enter the database, or you may now choose any database you wish



TIPS

- Any of the other databases – should open once your login name/email password combination has been entered. The example given is an Ebscohost database, but the InfoTrac databases and others work the same way. A to Z Serials Resources database no longer requires a password on campus. From remote users the same password combination applies.
- If you are asked again for a password when actually opening a full-text article, try going back and entering that particular database. There are a very few entries in A to Z that we do not have access to.

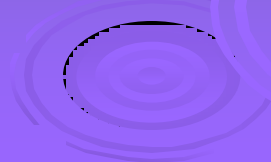

Online Databases: A Sampling

- *bigchalk eLibrary* – arts, business, communications, current events, government, mathematics, literature, physical education, social sciences
- *ebrary* – online textbooks
- *EBSCOHost* – Academic Search Premier, Business Source Premier, CINAHL nursing, PsycARTICLES, and Others
- *ERIC Plus Text* (education and teaching)
- *InfoTrac* – Religion & Philosophy Opposing Viewpoints, Business & Company Resources, Criminal Justice, and many Others
- *JSTOR* – older journals; broad topic range
- *NetLibrary*- online textbooks for all subjects
- *NewsBank*- full-text newspapers online
- *Wilson Web*- business, education, science, humanities, social sciences

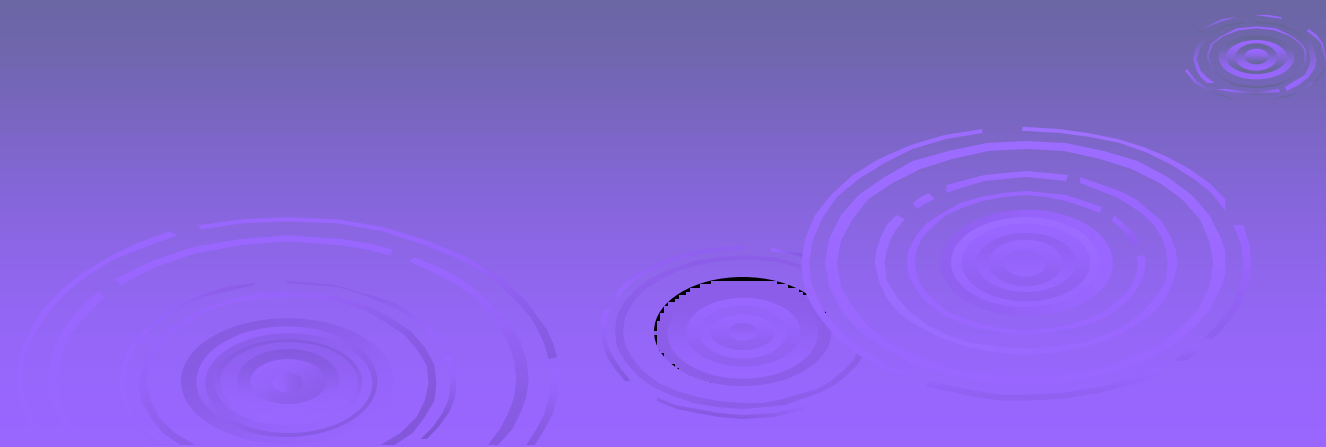


WHERE TO BEGIN
