Basic Assumptions

- All employees of faith-based organizations communicate spiritual values.
- Staff retention increases when employees feel a part of the purpose and goals of a faith-based organization.
- Leaders of faith-based organizations seldom find time to nurture their own spirits.
- Marketing of faith-based organizations is enhanced by staff, clients and families of clients who know what makes the organizations different from those that are not faith-based.

Goals

1. To identify the characteristics of a faith-based organization.
2. To facilitate a process that helps employees of faith-based social service organizations understand and claim their work as ministry.
3. To make employees aware of how their work contributes to the spiritual health and welfare of those served, the families of those served, and colleagues.
4. To provide a forum that builds a sense of dignity and depth among and with executive staff, managerial staff and line staff about the ministry that they do together.
5. Through individual and group experiences acknowledge and affirm staff in the work that they do.
