Come and be a part of an amazing experience with youth from all over the southeast! We will gather in Townsend, TN, right on the edge of the Great Smoky Mountains National Park, to explore America's most visited national park.

With a rich history of Cherokee and Appalachian cultures, this event will feature traditions of music and storytelling, along with time spent hiking in the woods and swimming in the creeks.

The park is also threatened, both by human presence and by invasive species. Participants will be witness to those effects as we discuss our roles in the stewardship of God's Creation. We will also give back to the National Park through service projects helping to keep the park in good shape for future visitors.

If you are flying, please arrive at the Knoxville Airport (TYS) no later than 2:30 pm EDT Sunday. You may make departing flights on Thursday no earlier than 10:00 am and no later than 3:00 pm. We ask those of you flying to rent vans from the airport. These vans will be used to transport people to job sites and park activities each day.
