We have reviewed your application for the proposed increase in water withdrawal from the Harpeth River. Pursuant to the *Tennessee Water Quality Control Act of 1977* (T. C. A. § 69-3-101 et seq.) and supporting regulations, the Division of Water Pollution Control is required to determine whether the activity proposed will violate applicable water quality standards. Subject to conformance with accepted plans, specifications and other information submitted in support of the application, the state of Tennessee hereby issues an Aquatic Resource Alteration Permit (enclosed).

It is the responsibility of the permittee to ensure that all contractors involved with this project have read and understood the permit conditions before the project begins. Failure to comply with the terms of this permit or other violations of the *Tennessee Water Control Act of 1977* is subject to penalty in accordance with T.C.A. § 69-3-115.
