

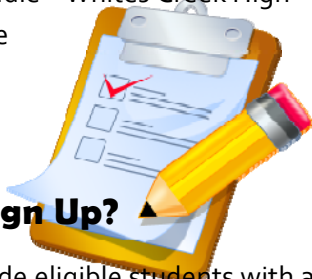
Who can apply for FREE After-School Math Tutoring?

Students must:

- 🍷 Participate in the free or reduced-price lunch program
- 🍷 Be currently enrolled in grades 5-9

Students must also attend one of the following schools:

How Can I Sign Up?

Schools will provide eligible students with a parent packet of information, including a sign-up form. The Packet will list all of the choices for tutors.

When will Math Academy Begin?

Beginning in October, students will meet with their Math Academy tutors on Tuesday and Thursday afternoons immediately after school dismissal. There will be 40 after-school sessions during the year. No sessions will be scheduled on the days that school is out. **FREE** Metro school bus transportation is available to your home afterwards

What do students do during a Math Academy session?

A typical day might include:

- 🍷 10 minutes for snacks
- 🍷 60 minutes for lively collaborative lessons that target specific math skills your child needs
- 🍷 15 minutes to help students connect their learning in Math Academy with their own math classroom activities

Math Bucks reward students

Math Academy tutors award “Math Bucks” to students for attendance, academic progress, and exceptional effort. Students can redeem their Math Bucks for a variety of educational incentives during the year.

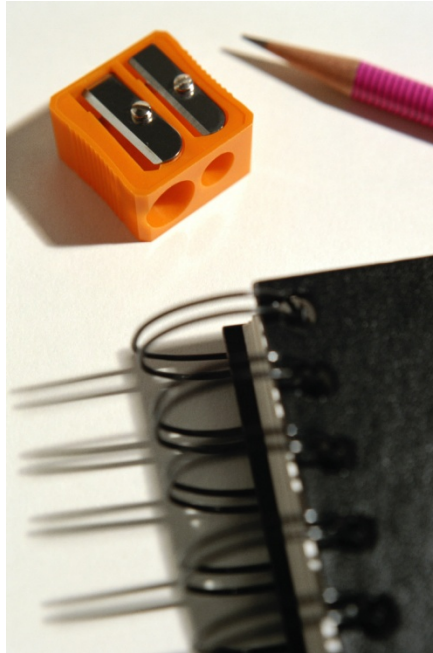
What makes Math Academy effective for students?

- 🍷 **Individualized attention** – A Personal Learning Plan will be created that identifies the math skills to be learned during the year.
- 🍷 **Small group settings**– Groups of 3-5 students give every student a chance to actively participate
- 🍷 **Collaborative and engaging activities** – Lively lessons help students connect math with real life experiences.
- 🍷 **Qualified teachers** - All tutors are certified, experienced teachers who know how to teach math.
- 🍷 **A proven curriculum** – Activities will help students go beyond memorization of math facts and formulas and gain the deeper understanding of math need to be successful in high school.
- 🍷 **Monthly Progress Reports** - will be sent home identifying the skills that have been mastered as well as the areas needing further work.
- 🍷 **Recognition of students** – A Graduation Ceremony at the end of the year will be held to recognize student achievement.
