CANCELLATIONS, CHANGES, SUBSTITUTIONS

All camp sizes are limited. Space is assigned on a first come, first served basis, based on date of payment, not date of application. To receive a refund, you must notify Owl's Hill of your cancellation or change **at least 2 weeks** prior to the start of the camp session you are canceling or changing. There is a **20% fee** for cancellations, substitutions, or session changes to Screech Owl, NatureRanger and Naturalist's Camp reservations and a **\$15.00 fee** for cancellations, substitutions or changes to all other camps and Parents' Nights. Change or substitution fees for **summer** camps may be waived prior to April 1.
