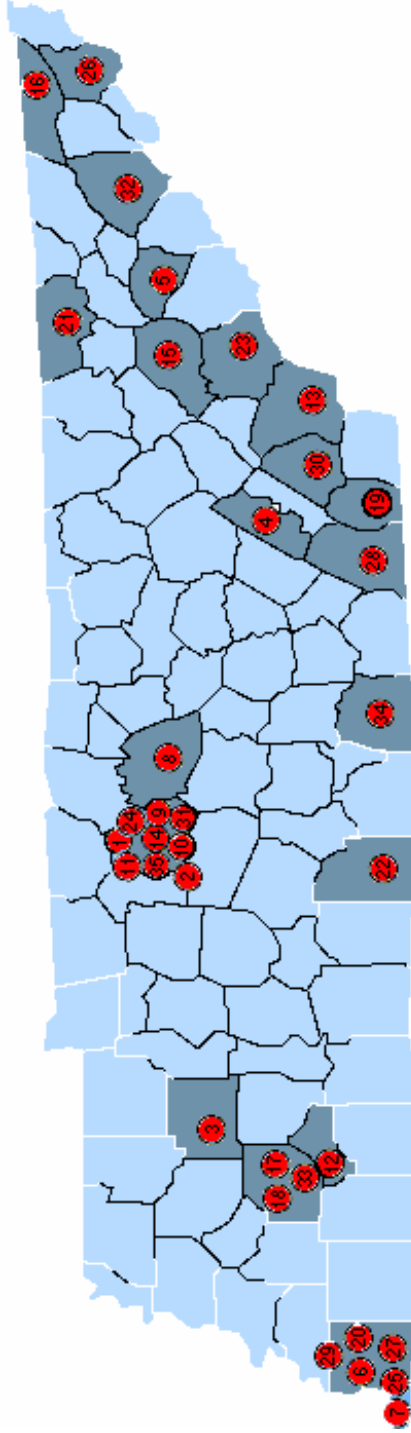

- 🏛️ TICUA members enrolled 23% of students and awarded 31% of degrees in Tennessee for 2003

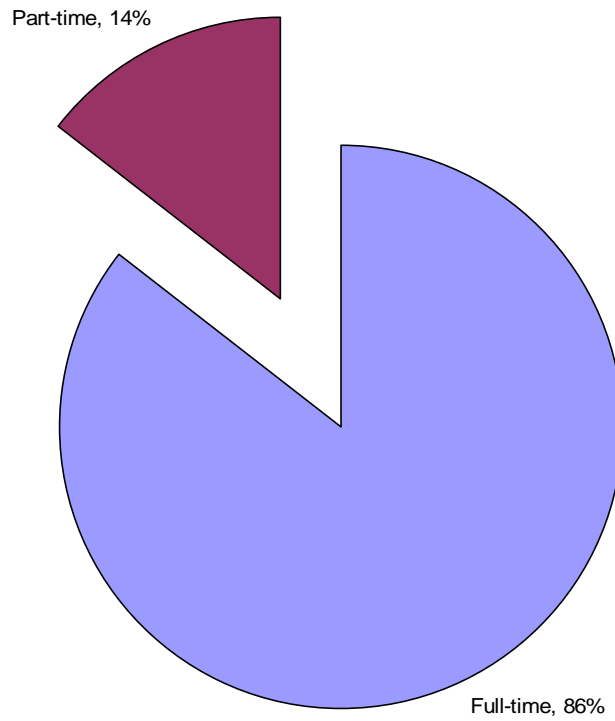

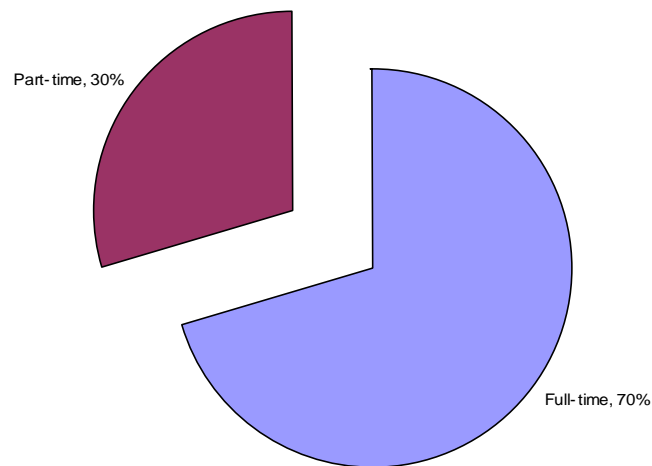

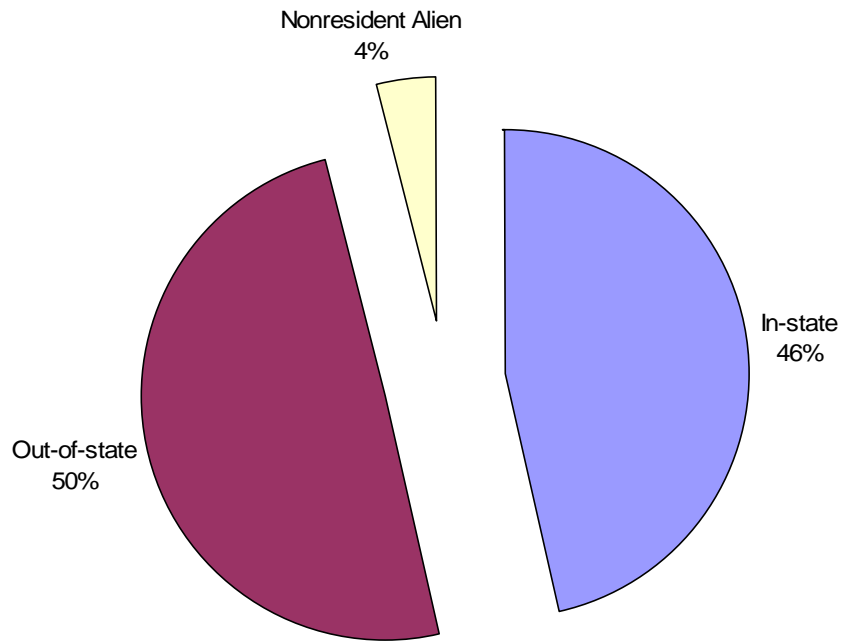
Undergraduate Enrollment by Attendance Status ~ Fall 2003



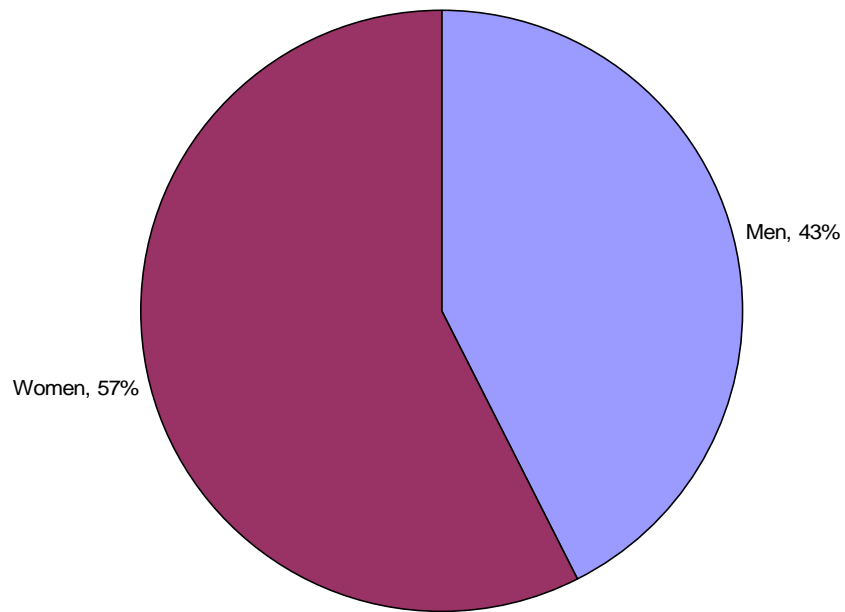
Graduate and First Professional Enrollment by Attendance Status ~ Fall 2003



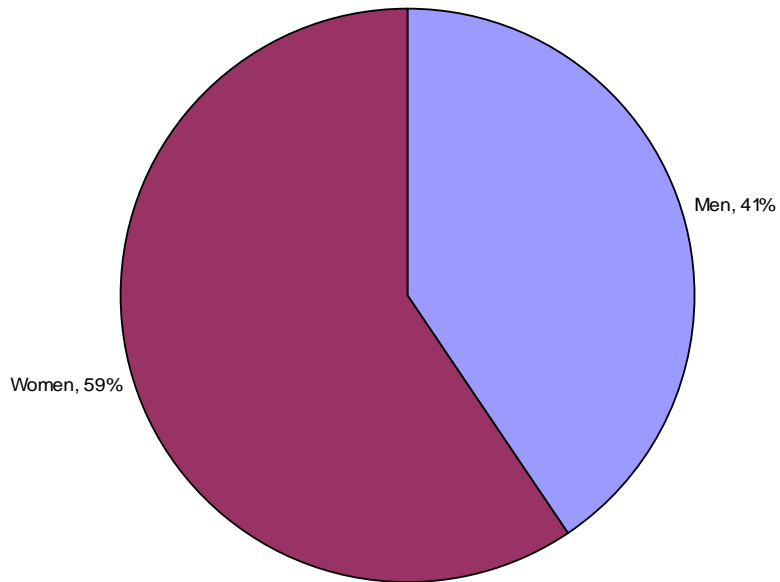
Enrollment by Residency ~ Fall 2002



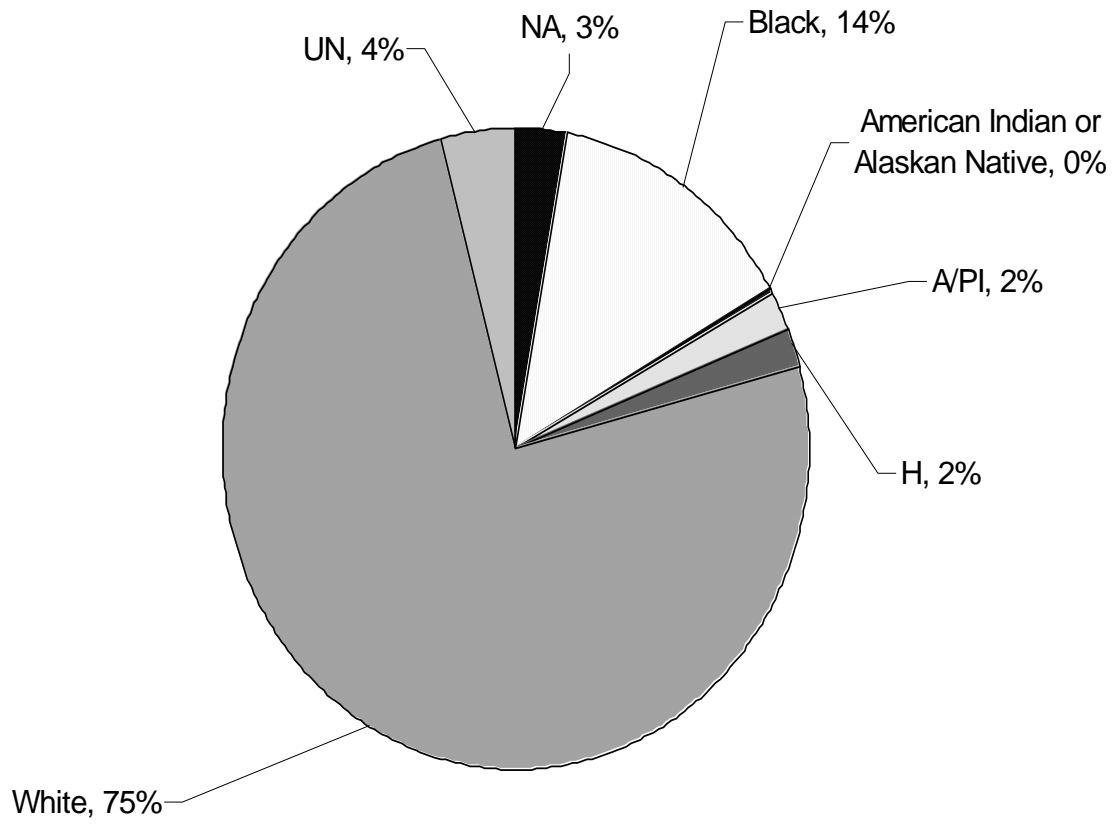
Undergraduate Enrollment by Sex ~ Fall 2003



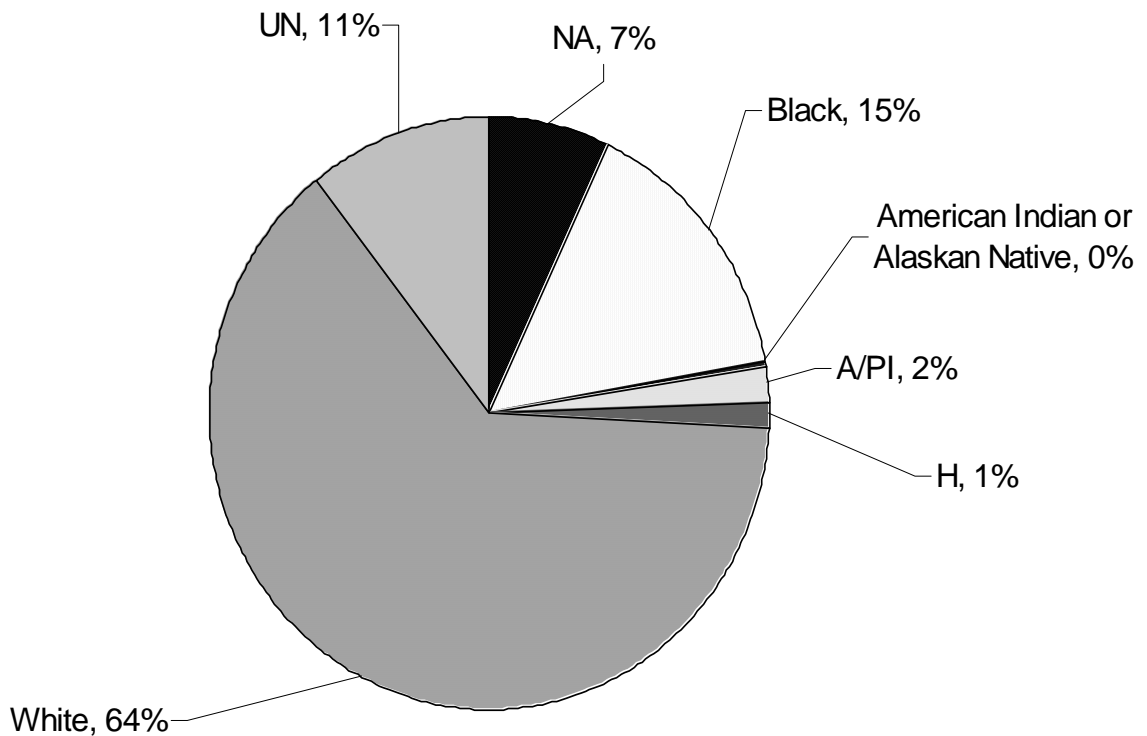
Graduate and First Professional Enrollment by Sex ~ Fall 2003



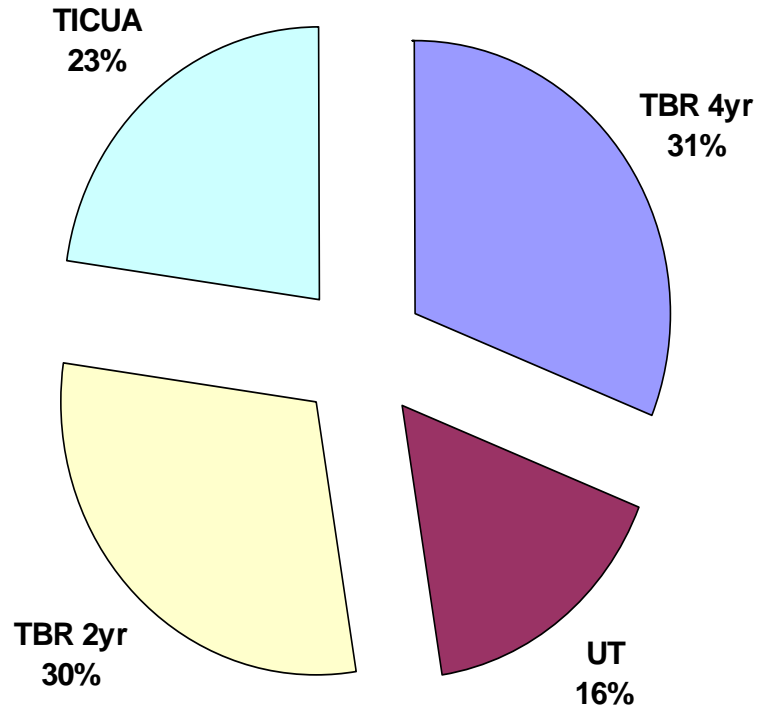
Undergraduate Enrollment by Ethnicity ~ Fall 2003



Graduate & First Professional Enrollment by Ethnicity ~ Fall 2003



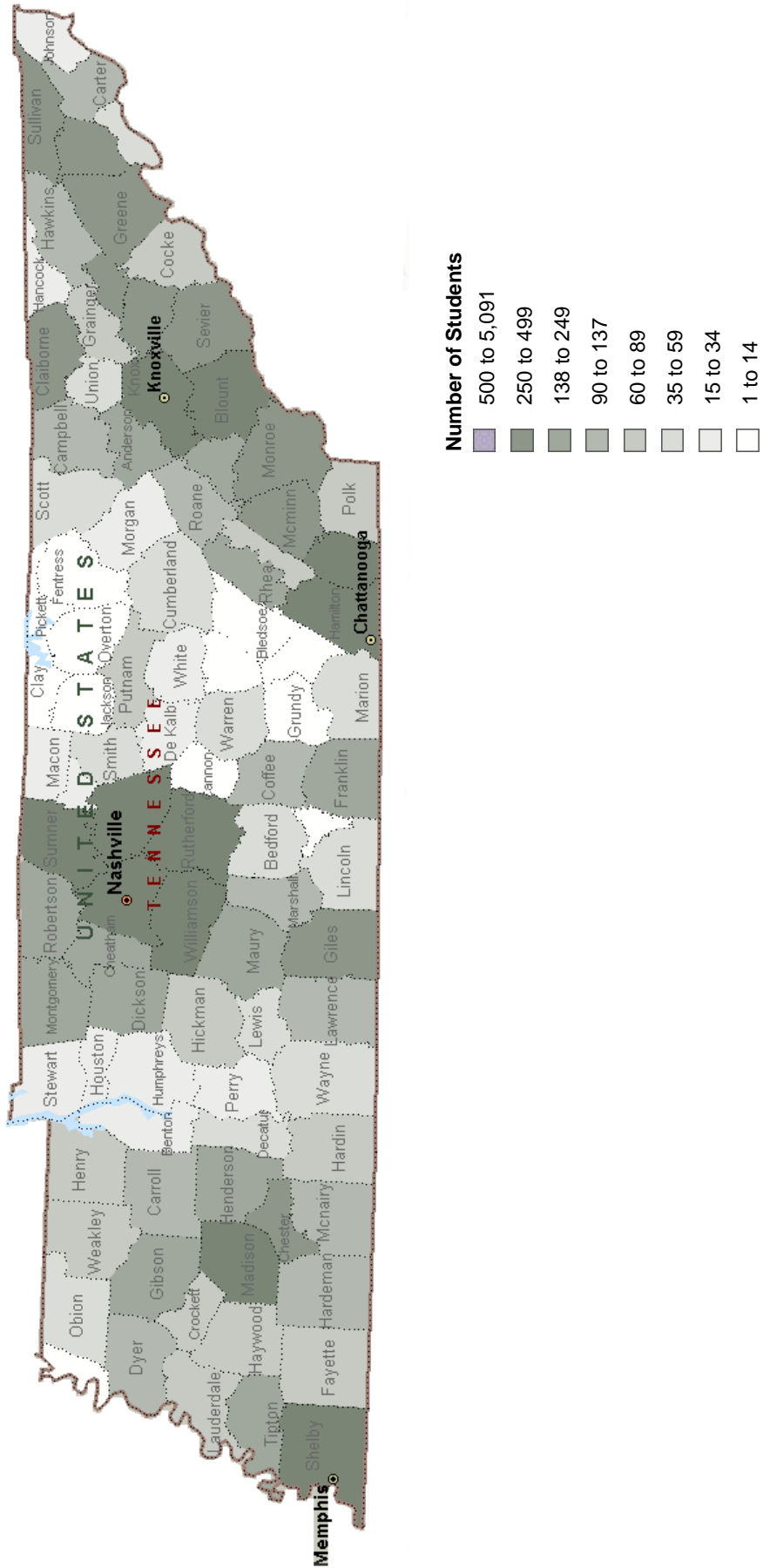
Enrollment Share by Sector ~ Fall 2003



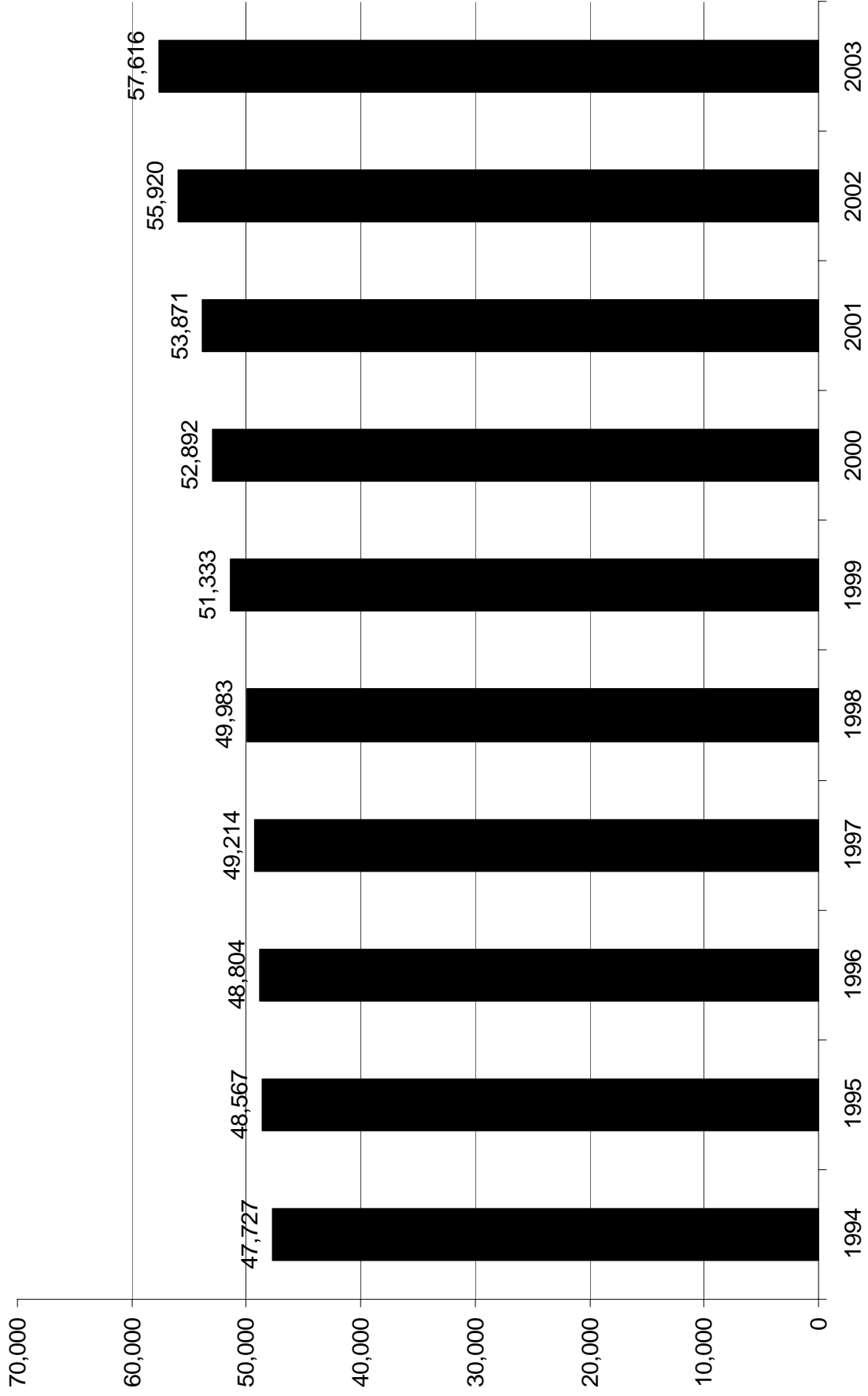

TICUA Enrollment by County ~ Fall 2002

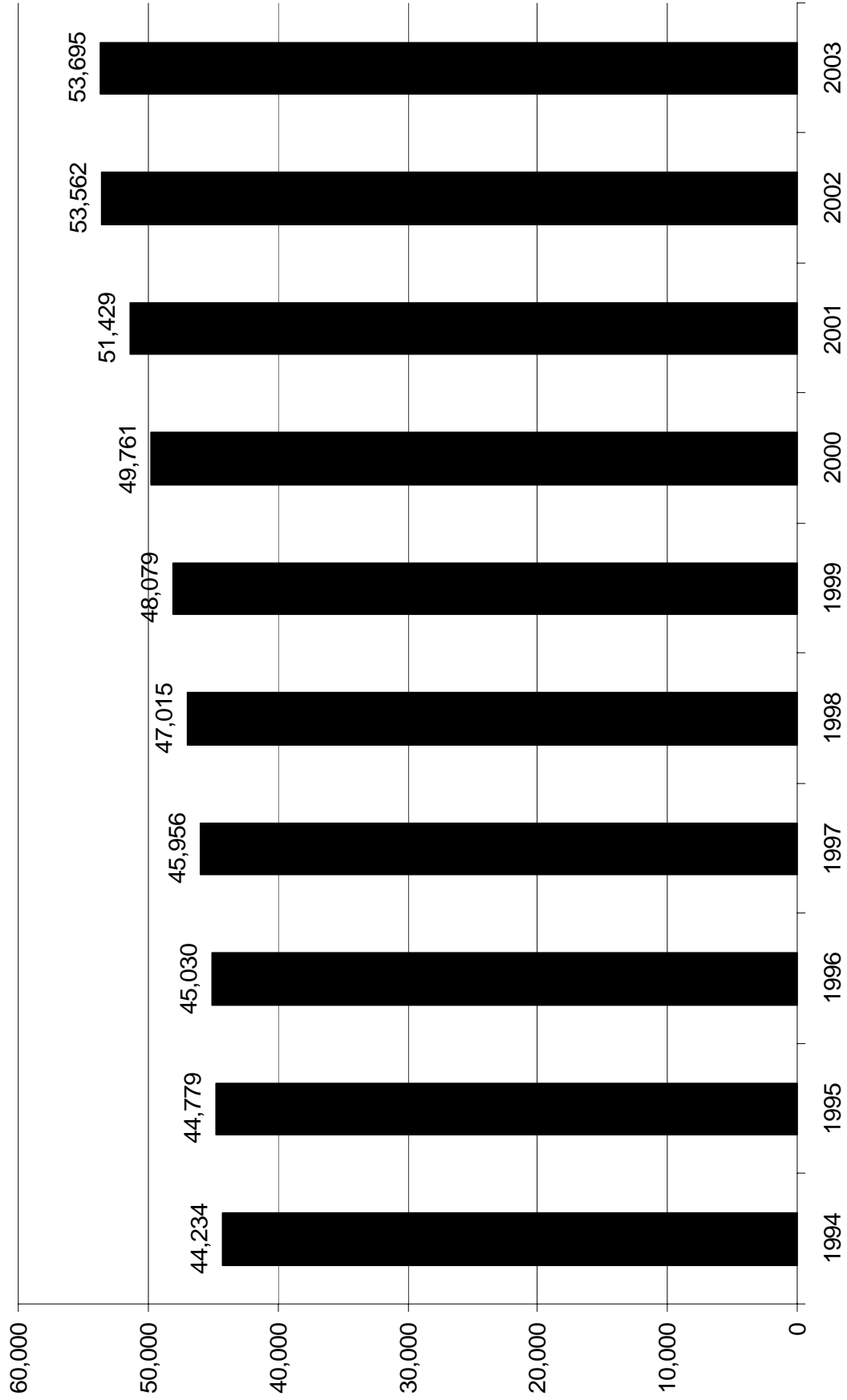


Headcount Enrollment ~ 10 Year Trend



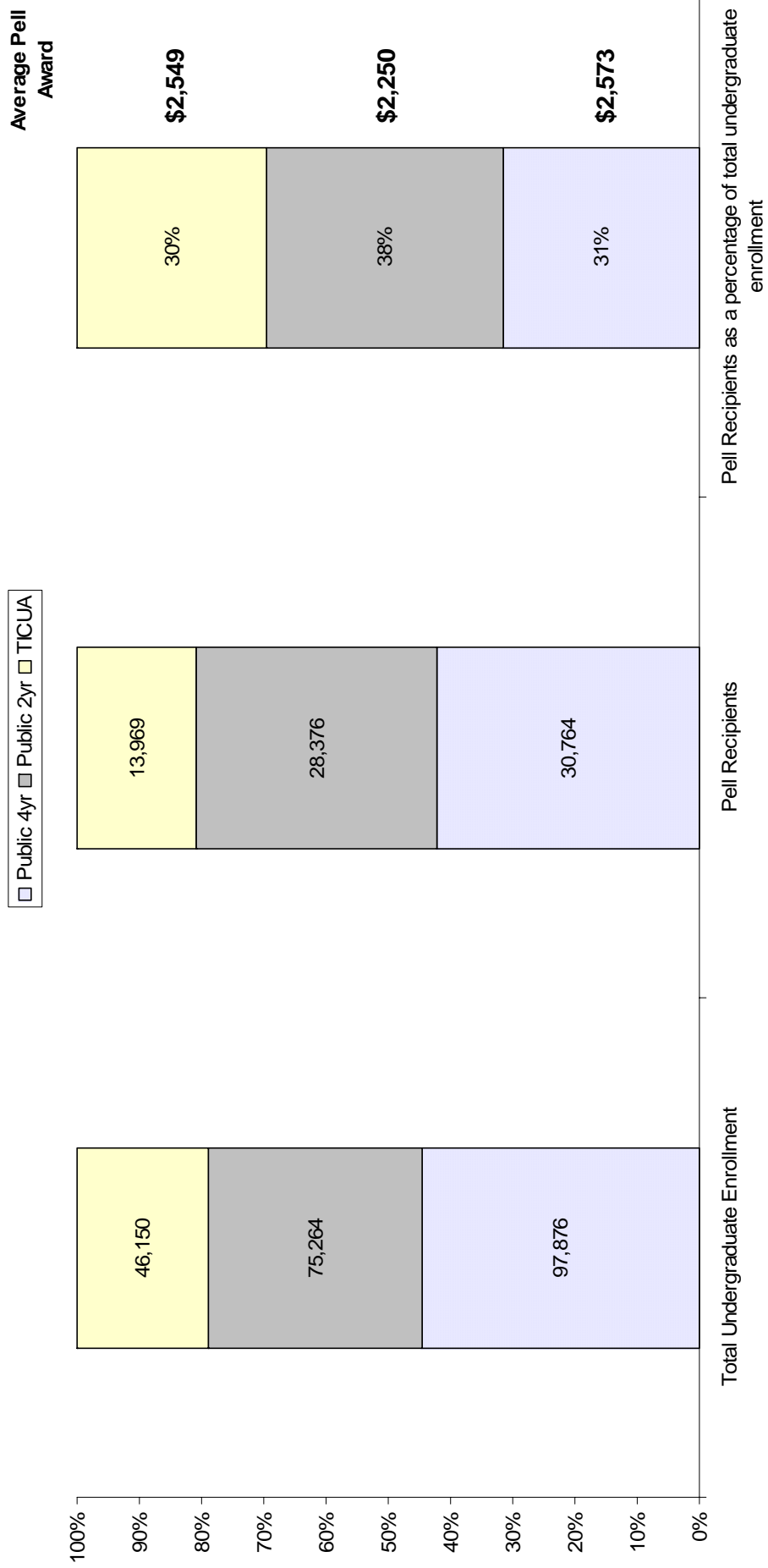
Total undergraduate and graduate headcount for TICUA Membership.

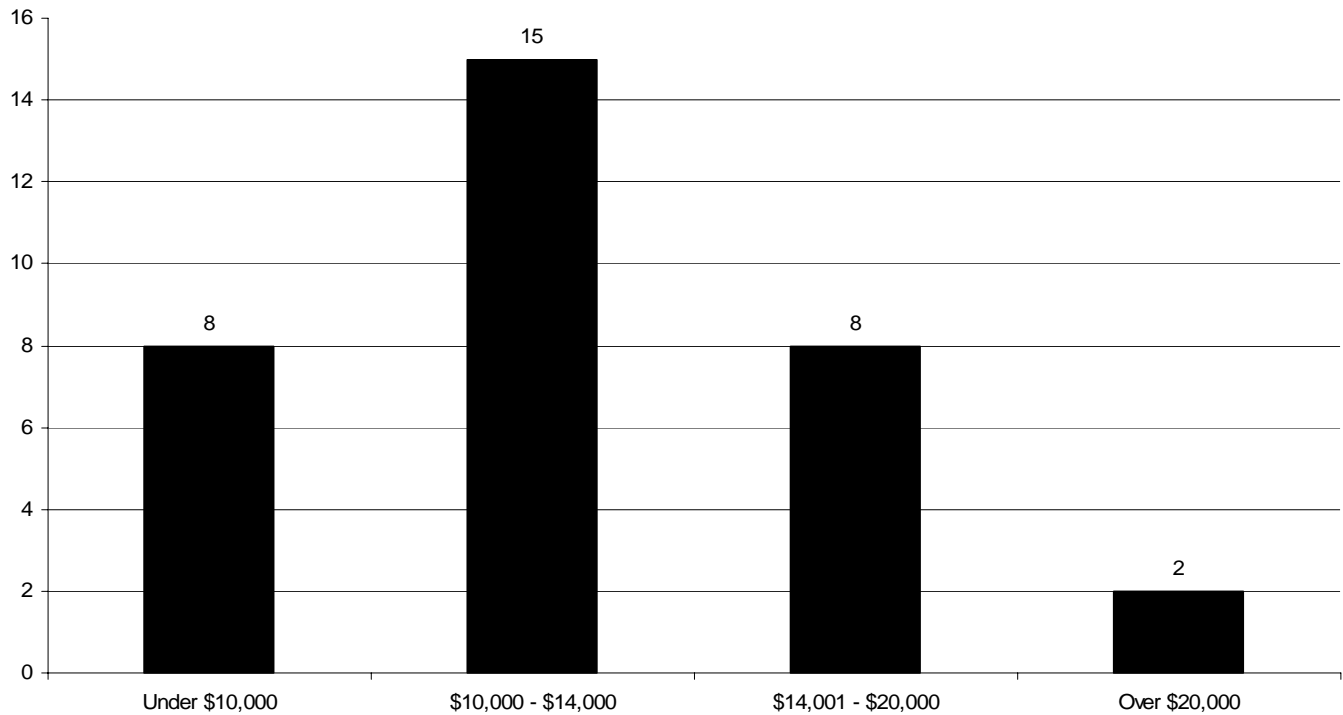
