About Big Brothers Big Sisters

The 2009 Franklin Wine Festival is a benefit for Big Brothers Big Sisters of Middle Tennessee, and all funds will be used to serve more children in need with a mentor. In 2008, Big Brothers Big Sisters served over 2,200 Middle Tennessee children. Kids with a mentor are 52% less likely to skip school, 46% less likely to begin using illegal drugs, and 27% less likely to use alcohol.

It takes about \$1,000 to mentor one child for one year. Big Brothers Big Sisters funds go toward the volunteer recruitment, the application and screening process, reference checks, background checks, and supporting the match between the "Big" and "Little".
