JOHNSON, PRICE & SPRINKLE AND BANK OF AMERICA UNITE TO SPONSOR A HABITAT FOR HUMANITY HOME

ASHEVILLE, N.C. (May 10, 2010) – At **12noon this Friday, May 14**, two financial companies will come together to raise the first wall on their jointly sponsored Habitat house – **the 2010 Johnson, Price & Sprinkle/ Bank of America house**. This is the fourth year of involvement for Johnson, Price & Sprinkle (JP&S) and the second for Bank of America. In addition to providing funds, both companies will also provide volunteers to help build the house.

The wall raising event will take place in Habitat’s Woodland Court neighborhood. The short speaking program will include words from the sponsoring groups, Habitat representatives and the McMillan partner family. Executive Director Lew Kraus will then invite the family and house sponsors to join together to raise the first wall of the home.

Since 1983, Asheville Area Habitat for Humanity has welcomed 200 Buncombe County families to safe, decent and affordable houses. Habitat homes, which are *HealthyBuilt* certified, are sold at no profit to partner families, who pay back a no-interest loan.
