Series with Red Hawks tilts to CU

Over the last six seasons, Cumberland has won 10 of 13 meetings Saturday's foe, Martin Methodist, including a 5-2 record at the Dallas Floyd Recreation Center. The Red Hawks have won the last two meetings in Lebanon, 79-66 last year and 75-74 in 2008. Cumberland won nine consecutive meetings in the series from 2004-07, including in the first round of the TranSouth Championships in 2006. CU's average margin of victory during the nine-game winning streak was 14.2 points.

Last year against MMC

Cumberland split the two contests against Martin Methodist last season, dropping a 79-66 decision at home before ending a three-game losing streak in the series with a 55-52 triumph in Pulaski. In Lebanon Chaquaila Gaten scored 19 points for the Bulldogs and Simone Ryan added 18, but the Bulldogs were just 4-for-19 from 3-point range in the loss. MMC led 35-30 at the half and pulled away after the break behind 25 points apiece from T'Qwana Pendergrast and Whitney Robison. The duo also combined for 26 rebounds. In Pulaski the Bulldogs forced 29 turnovers and erased an eight-point deficit

for the victory despite shooting only 32 percent from the field. Bona Ogada scored 14 points to lead CU and Tamara Gonzalez added 10. Robison had 16 points and 20 rebounds for MMC.

Bulldogs drop another close one

Cumberland lost for the sixth time in seven games with Thursday's 69-63 defeat to No. 1 Union, with five of the defeats coming against ranked opponents. The average margin in the five losses is just 6.7 points (four of six points or less). The Bulldogs continued to get close, but have been unable to pull out victories in the closing minutes. A 14-3 spurt by Union after Cumberland took a four-point lead midway through the second half was too much for the home team to overcome. Cumberland lost 67-65 to then 13th-ranked Univ. of the Cumberlands on December 30 in the final game of the Cumberland Classic and has also dropped a 59-53 decision to sixth-ranked Freed-Hardeman and a 70-65 loss at 19th-ranked Bethel Univ. Discouraging as the losses may be, last year CU dropped games to the same five opponents by an average of 25.2 points per game (with conference foes, in the first meetings of the year).

Bulldogs get balanced production in loss

Despite Thursday's loss to top-ranked Union, Cumberland shot the ball much better from the field and spread out the scoring, with four players netting double figures. Keshia Brown led the way with 15 points, her eighth straight double-digit performance, but Brittany Cash posted 13 points, including a trio of 3-pointers, just her fifth outing this season in double figures and first since Dec. 12. Allysia Bailey added 12 and 11 points, respectively, while freshman Joy Ford enjoyed her best game, posting six points and a team-high seven rebounds in 25 minutes of action after Ashley Whitmore played only three minutes in the first half with two quick fouls. Cumberland also gave itself an opportunity to win by committing just 14 turnovers and making 10-of-11 free throws.

What can Brown do for you?

After getting off to a very slow start this season, failing to score in double figures in her first four games of the season, junior Keshia Brown found a new gear starting December 2 at Hiwassee College and has reeled off a stretch of double digits efforts in nine of the last 10 contests, scoring 14.1 points per game in those outings. Head coach Jeremy Lewis started bringing the Clarksville, Tenn., native off the bench eight games ago, with much success, as Brown has averaged 15.1 points in the eight contests, including 17 points against the University of the Cumberlands, 15 versus Freed-Hardeman and Union, 16 at Trevecca Nazarene and a career-best 20 at Bethel University, all ranked foes. In TranSouth Conference action Brown is netting 15.2 points per game, shooting 78 percent (36-of-46) from the foul line. Overall she leads the Bulldogs in scoring with 12.1 points per game, making 41 percent from the floor and 77 percent at the free throw line.

Bulldogs step behind the arc

Cumberland shot 37 percent (47-for-126) from 3-point range through the first nine games of the year, but the Bulldogs made only 21 percent (11-for-53) from behind the arc through its first five TranSouth contests. CU finally found the range in Thursday's loss to No. 1 Union, hitting 5-of-13 from 3-point range, the team's most makes since making six December 29 against Tennessee Wesleyan. The Bulldogs had made three or less trifectas in five straight outings after starting the year with four or more 3-pointers in a game

Bailey's play much more consistent

Junior guard Allysia Bailey's play through the nonconference portion of the schedule was uneven to say the least, with good games mixed with bad ones and little in-between. Usually the good and bad came one right after the other as well. But the Knoxville, Tenn., native has put together a fine stretch of contests over the last seven games, scoring in double figures in six of the seven outings and averaging 10.6 points per game during the stretch. Bailey was coming off the bench until the last two contests. She has been driving to the basket more of late as well, getting to the foul line 15 times in the last four games compared to just 14 trips to the charity stripe in the first 10 games of the year. season she is averaging 10.2 points per game in 24.6 minutes per outing, sharing time at point guard with senior Angie Wells.

Different post player steps up each night

First-year head coach Jeremy Lewis settled on a three-player rotation at the forward positions over the last three weeks, starting junior Ashley Whitmore and freshman Stephanie Martin and bringing sophomore Simone Ryan off the bench. That combination worked well, with the trio averaging a combined 18.5 rebounds per game. Ryan leads the way on the glass, grabbing a team-high 6.9 caroms per game, while Martin is second on the club with 5.8 rebounds per game and Whitmore is bringing down 4.9 boards an outing. But because of Union's Zeinab Chan and Whitmore's two quick fouls Thursday night, freshman Joy Ford saw her most significant action of the year and responded better than anyone expected, chipping in six points (could have easily been 10 with three missed putbacks) and a team-high seven rebounds. Rebounding is a key component in Lewis' perimeter-style offense, and Ford's emergence can only help the Bulldogs in the present as well as the future. Martin has probably been the team's most pleasant surprise all season,

averaging 7.3 points per game along with her 5.8 boards. The Florence, Ala., native put up 10 points and grabbed six rebounds versus Freed-Hardeman and had 10 points and nine boards at Bethel. Meanwhile, Ryan and Whitmore have really struggled from the field, combining for just six double figure scoring games but five double-digit rebounding efforts.

Landers out indefinitely

Freshman guard Kristi Landers started the first six games of the season but has been sidelined since December 2 with plantar fasciitis. She was scheduled to return in four weeks, which would have been in time for the conference slate, but the Briarcrest Christian HS product has still not been able to practice and her return this season is up in the air. If she is able to play again, it would be in late February at the earliest.

Bulldogs ink Seymour's Cowan

Cumberland women's basketball coach Jeremy Lewis announced the signing of Seymour, Tenn., native Casie Cowan to scholarship papers for the 2010-11 academic year. Cowan is the first signee for Cumberland's squad for next season. Cowan has played four seasons for coach Andy Rines at Seymour High School, earning All-District 3-AA honors as a sophomore and junior and All-Region 2-AA accolades last season. She was named to the *Knoxville News-Sentinel* Prep XTra Preseason Second Team for this season after garnering Honorable Mention honors at the end of the 2008-09 campaign. Seymour was ranked seventh in east Tennessee in the preseason as well. Cowan averaged 11 points and three assists per game as a junior. The Lady Eagles won Region 2-AA last season and made the state sectionals. She is the daughter of Christy West and Rod Cowan and is also a 2008 Junior Rodeo Champion in Breakaway Roping.

Cumberland picked fifth in preseason

The Cumberland women's basketball program was picked seventh in a vote of league coaches released during the TranSouth Conference Media Day in Jackson, Tenn. Defending national champion Union University was the unanimous choice as the top team in the conference. Union received all seven first-place votes and 63 points in the Preseason Coaches Poll, while Freed-Hardeman, Trevecca Nazarene and Bethel Univ. were unanimous choices as the Nos. 2, 3 and 4 teams in the league, respectively. Lyon College (33), Martin Methodist (26), Cumberland (25), Blue Mountain (12) and Mid-Continent (9) rounded out the preseason poll. At least one TranSouth Conference team has reached the NAIA championship game in each of the last five years, with a conference member winning the national title in four of the five seasons. Cumberland reached the title game in 2007 before falling to Lambuth Univ.
