Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

We have great news we would like to share with you about NaCoMe. As you know, over the past decade NaCoMe has gone through a transformation, replacing many of the cabins and upgrading some of the facilities. Most exciting of all, this has enabled its ministry to soar, with the number of people using the camp dramatically higher than a decade ago.

This is more important than most people realize. In surveys of Presbyterians, 70% report “one particular learning or spiritual growth experience that had great significance” in shaping their Christian life. Half the time that experience came before the age of 17, and the most common setting was at a camp or retreat. For those who became ministers the numbers are even higher. There can be little doubt about the importance of church camps in the lives of all Christians, particularly the youth.

This transformation at NaCoMe has been possible because of people like you. NaCoMe receives no financial support directly from the Presbyteries, so it is only through the generosity of individuals and churches that this has been possible, and we are grateful for your support. It is quite probable you have played an important role in someone’s spiritual development without even knowing it.

There is still much to do at NaCoMe as the remaining facilities are old and largely worn out. The spring house, which supplies the camp’s water, underwent major repairs last spring. Some of the old cabins need a new roof, and the old upper and lower lodges, still in use for large groups, are in deplorable condition, and HVAC units and hot water heaters are aging and will soon need to be replaced. Because camper fees are intentionally held low in order to encourage attendance, revenues do not cover these shocks to operations.

The Board of Governors is requesting your support in securing the future of NaCoMe. Please take a moment to review the website and information on NaCoMe. Consider the importance of church camps in spiritual formation, and then give an amount that makes you feel really good. The person whose life you help change may even be someone you know.
