“CHANGE” FROM STUDENTS BRINGS CHANGE IN THE COMMUNITY

Benjamin Franklin once said, that a penny saved is a penny earned. Well that is certainly true for students at Pennington, Jones Paideia and Thomas Edison Elementary Schools. Students at these schools, as well as the University School of Nashville, are participating

in a national program called Penny Harvest that PENCIL is administering in Nashville. It is designed to teach students about the power of philanthropy, build leadership skills and educate them about needs that exist within their community.


In the fall students collected pennies with a goal of filling 25 or more sacks – that’s 750 pounds of pennies! Then, student leaders are selected to be part of roundtable discussions, where they examine the needs that exist in our city and which local charity or nonprofit should receive their donation.

The program, started in 1991 by the organization Common Cents out of NYC, has expanded to cities in Colorado, Florida, Washington and now Tennessee, collecting \$5.9 million in grants for community organizations.
