CU makes NAIA regional field

Cumberland received an at-large berth into this year's NAIA Baseball Championship Opening Round, the 21st straight season the Bulldogs will play in the postseason. CU has won the Region XI Tournament the last five seasons and posted Super Regional victories from 2004-07, advancing to the NAIA World Series in Lewiston, Idaho. The Bulldogs won the national championship in 2004 and lost in the championship game in 2006. Cumberland has played in 10 NAIA World Series overall, all since 1988.

Bulldogs find success in May

As with many successful college baseball programs in both the NCAA and NAIA, Cumberland University has played some of its best during the month of May, but especially during this decade when the Bulldogs have made four NAIA World Series appearances in the last five seasons. CU is 68-19 during the month of May over the last seven seasons, winning double-figure games four straight years from 2004-07, all campaigns in which the Bulldogs ended the season at the World Series in Lewiston, Idaho.

Limited history versus tourney field

Pitching leads way for CU

Cumberland headed into the 2009 season rather uncertain about its pitching staff after losing more than 90 percent of its innings from last year. Senior Eric Spivey is included in the number, though he returned this season after having offseason shoulder surgery. Spivey tossed 72.1 innings in 2008 but has worked just 16.2 this year. The Bulldogs have posted a 4.58 team ERA, ranking 35th nationally, and three new faces have stepped into the weekend rotation -- transfers Shawn Schaefer and Richard Timbrook and redshirt junior Robert Post. The trio has registered a cumulative 20-7 overall mark with a 3.22 ERA in 226.1 innings of work this season, striking out 172 with opponents batting only .233. Transfer Adam Sprague and senior James Parker have also worked more than 40 innings for the Bulldogs, with the five hurlers tossing 80 percent of the team's innings. CU has allowed four runs or fewer in 29 of the team's 55

games this season (53 percent), posting a 21-8 record in those contests.

Kautz hot as firecracker at the plate

Junior Max Kautz kept up his torrid pace at the plate during last week's TranSouth Championships, going 10-for-21 with four runs scored and seven RBIs in four contests. Kautz collected three hits in the first two games of the tournament, against Martin Methodist and Freed-Hardeman, and had two hits versus Lyon College and Union University. Kautz has hit safely in his last 10 games, batting .511 (23-for-45) with six extra-base hits, nine RBIs and 15 runs scored during the stretch. The Palo Alto, Calif., native has really been hot since March 21, posting a .464 batting average (45-for-97) with 13 extra-base hits, 20 RBIs and 33 runs scored. The Bulldogs are 21-9

since Kautz became a regular in the lineup, with the rightfielder missing three games because of an infection in his foot. Kautz started the season slowly, batting .286 in 28 at-bats in the first 20 games of the season. During his current hot stretch the Palo Alto, Calif., native has posted 17 multi-hit and 11 multi-run games and has hit safely in 22 of his last 24 contests. For the season Kautz is batting a team-leading .419 with eight doubles, five home runs, 26 RBIs and 39 runs scored in just 38 games.

Alexander continues climb

After missing all but one game of the 2008 season because of injury, senior Clint Alexander has picked the right time of year to come around at the plate. Alexander is batting .397 (27-for-68) over his last 21 games (19 starts) with seven doubles,

two home runs, 12 RBIs and 14 runs scored. He has raised his batting average from .189 on March 27 to its current .306, a total of 117 points. The Murfreesboro, Tenn., native has been even better over his last 11 starts dating to April 17, batting .439 (18-for-41) with four doubles, seven RBIs and nine runs scored. He collected seven hits, scored four times and drove in two runs in last week's TranSouth Championships, including a double in the ninth in the opener against Martin Methodist that plated the tying run and sent the game into extra innings, a contest the Bulldogs won 8-6 in 12 innings. For the season Alexander has 10 doubles, three home runs, 20 RBIs and 20 runs scored in 38 contests.

numbers or eight victories posted by teammates Robert Post and Richard Timbrook, but the junior lefthander has been just what the doctor ordered for an inexperienced Bulldog pitching staff – tough, consistent and an innings-eater on Fridays in conference play. Schaefer posted another clutch performance in last week’s TranSouth Championships, tossing a complete-game in a 7-5 victory over Lyon College, an elimination game for both clubs on the third day of the tournament. The lefthander allowed only eight hits to one of the best-hitting teams in the nation and struck out a career-best 13, keeping the Bulldogs alive in the tourney. The Pitt Meadows, British Columbia, native is 6-2 this season with a 4.16 ERA and 64 strikeouts in a team-high 80.0 innings of work. Opponents are batting just .247 against him. He has worked six innings or more in nine of his 10 starts and nine or more innings four times. His one hiccup this season came at Lyon College, where he allowed nine runs on 12 hits in five innings. In his other nine starts, Schaefer has a 3.04 ERA in 71.0 innings of work with 55 strikeouts and a .212 opponent batting average. He ranks 12th nationally in innings pitched per game (6.67) this season. Schaefer also has one thing no other Bulldog hurler possesses -- experience in the postseason. He pitched seven innings in a 4-2 loss to Lewis-Clark in the NAIA World Series two seasons ago for the University of British Columbia.

Middle of lineup struggles at TSAC Championships

The four players who generally hit in the Nos. 3-6 slots in the lineup for the Bulldogs – Michael Wheeler, Matt Greener, Sam Kikla and Tyler Fisher – entered last week’s TranSouth Championships batting a combined .364 for the season

with 42 doubles, 26 home runs and 149 RBIs. But the foursome did not fare well in last week’s four contests, especially Kikla, Greener and Fisher, who were a combined 8-for-50 (.160) with three doubles and just two RBIs. Kikla leads the squad in seven offensive categories, including home runs (11), RBIs (49), runs scored (44) and stolen bases (9). But the Malabar, Fla., native struck out seven times in the four contests and drove in just one run, that in the opener against Martin Methodist. Fisher collected two hits versus MMC but went hitless the rest of the tournament. Greener recorded one hit in three of the four outings but did not have an RBI. Wheeler was the only one of the four with decent numbers, registering five hits in 18 at-bats with a pair of home runs and four RBIs. The foursome was just 2-for-18 with runners in scoring position, though in their defense, the entire Bulldog squad hit just .196 (9-for-46) during last week’s tournament with runners in scoring position.

Post shows inexperience

Junior Robert Post pitched very ineffectively in his start last week versus Freed-Hardeman in the TranSouth Championships, probably his worst outing since February 22 of this year against Iowa Wesleyan. The righthander allowed seven runs, four earned, on six hits with four walks and six strikeouts. The line does not tell the inconsistency Post showed in the contest both with his command and also his mechanics. It was the first start of his career either in the conference tournament or in the postseason. The Mt. Juliet, Tenn., native has been almost unhittable at times this season for the Bulldogs, allowing just 41 hits in 72.2 innings of work and an opponent batting average of only .166. He ranks fourth nationally in opponent batting average and hits allowed

had to tie the contest in the ninth and win it in the 12th to pick up the victory. Timbrook has been perhaps the team's most consistent hurler this year, working at least six innings in seven of his last nine starts and posting seven quality starts during the stretch. The Independence, Mo., native won eight consecutive decisions from February 21-April 18 and six straight starts from March 15-April 18. He also has one save in 2009, getting the final three outs at Freed-Hardeman on April 25.

Tidbits

Cumberland has used 53 starting lineup in 55 games this season, and all of the repeats have come in the last six contests – in the first game of a doubleheader against Martin Methodist on April 30 and then in the first game of last week's TranSouth Championships, also against MMC;

in the second game of the April 30 twinbill versus MMC and versus Freed-Hardeman in the second game of last week's conference tournament; in the final two games of last week's TranSouth Championships the same lineup was used. CU has used 36 different players in 2009 because of injuries and suspensions ... Kyle West has started behind the plate in 22 of the last 24 games for the Bulldogs, dating to April 1 at Campbellsville ... After collecting only six hits in 32 at-bats (.188) over a 10-game stretch from April 15-25, junior Matt Holliman has gone 8-for-25 (.320) over the last six games with nine RBIs, seven runs scored and six extra-base hits. He hit home runs in four consecutive contests from April 30-May 5 and has hit safely in all six games.

CU places eight on All-TranSouth team, Hunt voted Coach of the Year

Cumberland placed eight players on the All-TranSouth baseball teams and head coach Woody Hunt was voted TSAC Coach of the Year, as announced by the conference office during the TranSouth Championships. The Bulldogs were the most represented school on the two 18-member teams, with four CU players on both the First and Second Team. Cumberland had two players who received Gold Glove awards as the best defensive players at their position in the league – West at catcher and Matt Greener at third base. CU also had 12 players selected as TSAC Scholar-Athletes, the most of any team in the conference – Clint Alexander, Matt Burton, Will Curry, Briggs Dixon, Chris Fanning, Kautz, Jeremy Malmendier, Corey Merrill, Post, Blake Simmons, Matt Vance and Lee Verweel.

Kikla, Sprague named TSAC Player, Pitcher of the Week

Juniors Sam Kikla and Adam Sprague were named the TranSouth Player and Pitcher of the Week, respectively, on April 13 for their performances in victories over ninth-ranked Campbellsville and No. 18 Trevecca. Sprague and TNU's Wesley Griggs shared the Pitcher of the Week honors. Kikla helped the Bulldogs to a 3-1 mark for the week, including a 19-8 victory over Campbellsville and a series win against Trevecca. The junior infielder belted four home runs during the week, with a pair versus Campbellsville. In the second game Sprague struck out Brian Dirheimer, the potential winning run, with two runners on in the eighth, and recorded two more strikeouts in the ninth to post his first save of the season.

Kautz, Post selected TSAC POW

Juniors Max Kautz and Robert Post were selected the TranSouth Conference Player and Pitcher of the Week, respectively, March 29 as named by the conference office. Kautz hit .563 during CU's four victories with nine runs scored, three doubles, one home run and five RBIs. He also drew two walks while posting a .938 slugging percentage. The Palo Alto, Calif., native posted at least two hits in all four games for the week. Kautz hit a game-winning two-run homer in the 10-inning, 11-10 victory over Lyon College in the first game of a doubleheader. Post tossed a five-inning no-hitter in his only appearance of the week. The Mt. Juliet, Tenn., native struck out eight and walked three against Lyon in the no-hitter and allowed just an unearned run on a throwing error in the contest.

Sprague voted TSAC Pitcher of the Week

Junior Adam Sprague was voted the TranSouth Conference Pitcher of the Week on February 23 after posting his second victory of the season, versus Iowa Wesleyan. The lefthander from Winter Park, Fla., tossed six innings, allowing just two earned runs, striking out six and walking two against the Tigers.

CU ranked 11th in preseason

The Cumberland baseball team ranked 11th in the 2009 NAIA Baseball Coaches' Preseason Top 25 Poll announced in November. The Bulldogs posted a 46-21 record in 2008 and finished the year one win shy of their fifth straight NAIA World Series appearance. The Bulldogs and 28th-year head coach Woody Hunt returned four starters from last year's club. CU had to replace almost its entire pitching staff that posted a team earned-run-average of 3.74 last season and allowed opponents to bat just .258. Gone from roster are eight pitchers who accounted for 85 percent of

last season's innings.

Hunt elected to Tennessee Sports Hall of Fame

Cumberland baseball coach Woody Hunt was be one of 11 greats inducted into the Tennessee Sports Hall of Fame on February 20 at the Renaissance Hotel in Nashville, Tenn. Others who were inducted include Sam Bartholomew, Jr., Philip Hutcheson, Joe Gilliam, Jr. (posthumous), Tommy Owen (posthumous), Andy Nelson, Sarah Ingram, Elliot Perry, Tim Priest, Stan Huntsman and Chip Kell. Hunt has served on the baseball staff at Cumberland for 30 years, three as an assistant in 1978, '79 and '81 and then as the head coach since 1982. CU was a two-year school his first two seasons and became a four-year institution beginning with the 1984 baseball season. The Belmont University graduate has compiled 1,193 victories in 27 seasons as head coach at CU and an 1,132-463-3 mark as head coach since 1984. He is one of only six coaches to register more than 1,000 career victories in NAIA. It marked the fifth Hall of Fame in which Hunt was inducted. He had previously been inducted into the NAIA, Cumberland, Boyle County [KY] and Tennessee Baseball Coaches Association Halls of Fame.

CU picked to win TranSouth

Cumberland's baseball team was picked to win the TranSouth Conference in a preseason poll of the league coaches announced in January by the conference office. Cumberland received six of the eight first-place votes in a poll of the league coaches and tallied 62 total points. Trevecca received the other two first-place votes and had 58 total points for second place. Union University, Martin Methodist and Lyon College ranked third, fourth and fifth, respectively, with Freed-Hardeman, Bethel College and Mid-Continent rounding out the poll. In 2008, Trevecca won the regular season title, with Cumberland taking the TranSouth Tournament championship. The Bulldogs won their fifth straight Region XI Tournament but fell one game shy of the NAIA World Series, losing in a best-of-three series to Union College (KY).

Woody Hunt

Head Coach • Belmont Univ./1980 • 28th Season • 1,225-512-3 (.705) overall



Cumberland University owes a great debt of gratitude to legendary and Hall of Fame head coach Woody Hunt for his great service not only to the baseball program but also to the athletic department and the University as well as the community of Lebanon.

Hunt begins his 28th season as head coach of the Bulldogs in 2009 and his 31st with the Cumberland program. He has amassed an impressive resume along the way and continues to add to his credentials with each passing year.

But even more importantly Hunt continues to play a major role within the overall landscape of the University as well as in the Lebanon and Wilson County communities where so many of his former players have settled into lives after baseball.

Hunt is one of only six coaches in history to register 1,000 career victories in the NAIA and heads into the '09 season with a 1,193-489-3 overall record. The Bulldogs have appeared in 10 NAIA World Series, including four in the last five seasons, but his most crowning program achievement came when CU claimed the 2004 national championship in Lewiston, Idaho. The Bulldogs have finished as the national runner-up on two other occasions, in 1995 and 2006.

Cumberland has won 16 conference championships during Hunt's tenure, including 10 in the Tennessee

Collegiate Athletic Conference (TCAC), five in the Mid-South Conference (MSC) and one in the TranSouth Conference (TSAC). CU has four district championships, 11 NAIA regional titles and has played in five super regionals as well.

The program has posted 20 seasons with 40 or more victories, including 16 of the last 17 years, while registering 50 or more wins seven times, all in the last dozen seasons. The 2004 squad set the school-record for victories with 59.

The Bulldogs have produced 51 NAIA All-Americans, including Steve Green, the only three-time All-American in program history. Seventy-two of Hunt's former players have signed professional contracts.

The Bulldogs have posted a 311-120 record over the last six seasons with five NAIA World Series appearances, one runner-up finish and one national title.

Hunt has also achieved individual success in the awards category, claiming 16 Coach of the Year honors, including the 2006 Rawlings National Coach of the Year award. He is a seven-time Southeast Region Coach of the Year and has also been a finalist for the National Coach of the Year Award four times.

Perhaps his greatest achievement lies in the facilities in which his team plays, practices and dresses. Cumberland has one of the finest baseball facilities in the nation, second to none in the NAIA, with Ernest L. Stockton Field and its 500 chairback seats and state-of-the-art press box, the Benton Jennings Indoor Hitting Complex and the Jeanette C. Rudy Clubhouse.
