No. 1 Union holds decisive series lead

Top-ranked and defending national champion Union University holds a decisive 44-2 all-time series record against Cumberland, with the Bulldogs winning just once in the last 16 meetings. Union's margin of victory since 2001 has been 24.4, while CU's lone victory came at home in 2007, a 79-66 triumph, with Kiana Robinson hitting six 3-pointers and netting 24 points, current graduate assistant C'Kala Humes posting 18 points and while Renae Williams chipping in 11 points for the Bulldogs.

Last year against Union

Cumberland lost both meetings last season against top-ranked Union by a combined 118 points, starting with a 101-34 defeat in Jackson in January. The Bulldogs shot just 23 percent from the field in that contest and no Cumberland player scored in double figures. In February's game in Lebanon, Chaquaila Gaten scored 15 points and was the only CU player with double digits, as the Bulldogs again struggled from the floor, making just 26 percent. Union led 98-25 combined at halftime in the two meetings last

season, with Union scoring 49 points in both games. Cumberland netted nine points in the first contest and 16 in the second outing.

Bulldogs on a downward streak

Cumberland has lost five of its last six games, with four of those defeats against ranked foes. The schedule does not get any easier with tonight's meeting against top-ranked Union at the Dallas Floyd Recreation Center. The average margin in the five losses is just 6.8 points, meaning a bucket here or a defensive stop there or one less turnover could have made the difference for first-year head coach Jeremy Lewis and his squad. Cumberland lost 67-65 to then 13th-ranked Univ. of the Cumberlands on December 30 in the final game of the Cumberland Classic and has also dropped a 59-53 decision to sixth-ranked Freed-Hardeman and a 70-65 loss at 19th-ranked Bethel Univ. Discouraging as the losses may be, the Bulldogs can take solace in this fact - last year CU dropped games to the same four opponents by an average of 14.8 points per game (with conference foes, in the first meetings of the year). So Lewis and his program are making strides, which everyone can see on the court as well as on the scoreboard. The next step is to make even bigger marks in the win column.

What can Brown do for you?

After getting off to a very slow start this season, failing to score in double figures in the first four games of the season, junior Keshia Brown found a new gear starting December 2 at Hiwassee College and has reeled off a stretch of double digits efforts in eight of the last nine

contests, scoring 14.0 points per game in those outings. She started coming off the bench seven games ago, with much success, as Brown has averaged 15.1 points in the seven contests, including 17 points against the University of the Cumberlands, 15 versus Freed-Hardeman, 16 at Trevecca Nazarene and a career-best 20 at Bethel University, all ranked foes. In TranSouth Conference action Brown is netting 15.2 points per game, shooting 42 percent (23-for-55) from the field and 74 percent (29-of-39) from the foul line. Overall she leads the Bulldogs in scoring with 11.9 points per game, making 42 percent from the floor and 75 percent at the free throw line.

Where are the 3-pointers?

Cumberland started the season red hot from 3-point range, making 37 percent (47-for-126) through the first nine games of the year, but the Bulldogs have cooled off considerably since the start of TranSouth action. Over the last five outings, CU has hit just 21 percent (11-for-53) from behind the arc and has not hit more than three 3-pointers in any of the five contests. Compare that to the first nine games when the Bulldogs made four or more trifectas in seven of the nine outings. The answer? Certainly better competition and defense from what is arguably the best women's basketball conference in the NAIA, but possibly an unfamiliarity because of the shuffling of the lineup starting just before conference play, allowing veterans like Keshia Brown and Simone Ryan to come off the bench.

Bailey learning from her mistakes

Junior guard Allysia Bailey's play through the nonconference portion of the schedule was uneven to say the least, with good games mixed with bad ones and little in-between. Usually the good and bad came one right after the other as well. But the Knoxville, Tenn., native has put together a fine stretch of contests since December 30 against the University of the Cumberlands,

scoring in double figures in five of the last six games and averaging 10.5 points per game during the stretch. Bailey was coming off the bench in all but the last contest. She has been driving to the basket more of late as well, getting to the foul line 13 times in the last three games compared to just 14 trips to the charity stripe in the first 10 games of the year. For the season she is averaging 10.2 points per game and averaging 24.5 minutes per outing, sharing time at point guard with senior Angie Wells.

Forwards combine for big numbers

First-year head coach Jeremy Lewis has settled on a three-player rotation at the forward positions over the last six games, starting junior Ashley Whitmore and freshman Stephanie Martin and bringing sophomore Simone Ryan

off the bench. The trio averages a combined 18.5 rebounds per game, with Ryan leading the way with 7.3 boards per contest and Martin adding 6.0 per outing. Ryan has five double figure rebounding games this season, including 14 against Tennessee Wesleyan and 10 versus 13th-ranked Univ. of the Cumberlands, but the Byhalia, Miss., native has struggled mightily from the field, making just 34 percent of her shots and averaging only 6.5 points per game. She may have turned a corner with Monday's 11-point outing at Bethel Univ., just her third double digit effort of the year. Martin's play has been up-and-down, definitely expected from a freshman, but the Florence, Ala., native put up 10 points and grabbed six rebounds versus Freed-Hardeman and had 10 points and nine boards Monday at Bethel and is netting 7.7 points per game this season. She also averaged 7.6 rebounds over a five-game stretch from December 12-January 9. Whitmore has been the steadying influence and has a pair of double-digit rebounding efforts this season, with 12 against Talladega College and 17 versus Blue Mountain. The Antioch, Tenn., native is averaging 5.2 caroms per game as well as 5.4 points per outing.

Landers out indefinitely

Freshman guard Kristi Landers started the first

six games of the season but has been sidelined since December 2 with plantar fasciitis. She was scheduled to return in four weeks, which would have been in time for the conference slate, but the Briarcrest Christian HS product has still not been able to practice and her return this season is up in the air. If she is able to play again, it would be in late February at the earliest.

Bulldogs ink Seymour's Cowan

Cumberland women's basketball coach Jeremy Lewis announced the signing of Seymour, Tenn., native Casie Cowan to scholarship papers for the 2010-11 academic year. Cowan is the first signee for Cumberland's squad for next season. Cowan has played four seasons for coach Andy Rines at Seymour High School, earning All-District 3-AA honors as a sophomore and junior and All-Region 2-AA accolades last season. She was named to the *Knoxville News-Sentinel* Prep XTra Preseason Second Team for this season after garnering Honorable Mention honors at the end of the 2008-09 campaign. Seymour was ranked seventh in east Tennessee in the preseason as well. Cowan averaged 11 points and three assists per game as a junior. The Lady Eagles won Region 2-AA last season and made the state sectionals. She is the daughter of Christy West and Rod Cowan and is also a 2008 Junior Rodeo Champion in Breakaway Roping.

Cumberland picked fifth in preseason

The Cumberland women's basketball program was picked seventh in a vote of league coaches released during the TranSouth Conference Media Day in Jackson, Tenn. Defending national champion Union University was the unanimous choice as the top team in the conference. Union received all seven first-place votes and 63 points in the Preseason Coaches Poll, while Freed-Hardeman, Trevecca Nazarene and Bethel Univ. were unanimous choices as the
