According to present United States Immigration regulations, no student who is a citizen of another country may be admitted to the United States unless he/she presents Form I-20, Certificate of Eligibility. Completed by the Cumberland University International Student Advisor upon acceptance and receipt of an enrollment deposit, Form I-20 lists detailed information, including the estimated cost of an academic year and the source and amount of funds available to the student.

You are required to certify that you will have available the money for your first academic year at Cumberland University. In computing your financial resources, you should keep in mind that you will not be allowed to seek or undertake employment during your first two years of study. If you are accepted, it will be necessary to have with you the money to cover all expenses for your first year of study when you arrive on campus. The United States Government's Immigrations Form I-20 will be mailed to you upon receipt of your enrollment deposit.
