(April 28, 2010) – On Wednesday, May 5 at 12 noon, less than six months from the day the first wall was raised, another family will receive ceremonial house keys to their new Habitat house. House sponsor Volvo Construction Equipment will present keys to the Castillo family in the Enka Hills neighborhood.

Joining Hortensia Castillo and her three children for the ceremony will be her friends and co-workers from Genova Diagnostics, as well as staff and volunteers from Asheville Area Habitat for Humanity and Volvo Construction Equipment. The public and media are invited to attend.
