Pitching at the forefront

The Bulldog pitching staff has been more than adequate in a season where CU lost more than 90 percent of its innings from a year ago. Senior Eric Spivey is the only returnee who tossed more than 12 innings last season, with the righthander working 72.1. But Spivey underwent offseason surgery and has worked just 12.1 innings this season, only four percent of the team's innings in 2009. The workhorses this year have become Shawn Sprague, Robert Post and Richard Timbrook, the team's weekend starters, as well as Adam Sprague and James Parker, all of whom have tossed more

than 30 innings. The Cumberland team ERA of 3.80 ranks 20th nationally, while the staff also ranks in the Top 25 in the country in hits allowed (16th, 6.91), walks allowed (18th, 2.31), earned runs allowed (18th, 3.13), opposing batting average (19th, .255) and runs allowed per game (24th, 4.16). The Bulldog defense also helps out, ranking 20th nationally in fielding percentage.

Post almost unhittable

Junior Robert Post has posted a host of impressive numbers this season for the Bulldogs, including a 1.62 earned-run-average, a 5-2 overall record and a .160 opponent batting average. But his most impressive statistic may be the 30 hits allowed in 55.2 innings of work. The Mt. Juliet, Tenn., native has given up four hits or less in eight of his nine appearances this season, all starts, including a five-inning no-hitter at Lyon College and three-hit shutouts against both Faulkner Univ. and Lambuth Univ. Post has also not allowed more than two earned runs in any of his nine starts this year. He has won his last four decisions, beating Union Univ. and Trevecca along the way with complete-game performances, one of five this season for the righthander.

Timbrook keeps on winning

Senior Richard Timbrook continues to impress with one important characteristic – he keeps putting W's on the board for the Bulldogs. Timbrook has won his last eight decisions and has not lost since the opening game of the season, February 13 at Auburn-Montgomery. The Independence, Mo., native has worked six or more innings in six of his nine starts this season, including a nine-inning affair this past weekend at Lambuth when he allowed just three runs on eight hits. Timbrook has given up two or fewer runs in five of his nine starts, including two earned runs in a span of four starts from March 15-April 4. The righthander batted through 5.2 innings in an 8-6 victory over Trevecca as well. His 59.2 innings leads the Bulldogs and he ranks

second with a 2.87 ERA and a .255 opponent batting average.

Schaefer a workhorse

Junior Shawn Schaefer's numbers are not nearly as eye-catching as teammates Robert Post or Richard Timbrook, but the lefthander has assumed a very important role for the Bulldogs in 2009 – Friday starter and workhorse. The Pitt Meadows, British Columbia, native has worked at least six innings in six of his seven starts this season, including nine innings twice and 10 innings once. Schaefer has also stayed in games at times to eat innings and continue getting outs in high-scoring affairs, such as the six runs he allowed in a 7-6 victory over then sixth-ranked Bellevue Univ. and the nine runs allowed in an 11-10 triumph over Lyon College. These two outings helped raise his current ERA to 4.26, but he has logged 57.0 innings of work, tops

on the squad before he missed this past weekend's start at Lambuth. Schaefer has allowed two runs or less in four or his last five outings, which includes victories over Bethel College and Union Univ. and a 2-1, 10-inning loss to Trevecca.

Kautz continues to swing hot bat

Junior Max Kautz knows exactly how to stay in the lineup for head coach Woody Hunt – keep swinging a hot bat. After hitting just .286 in 28 at-bats through the first 20 games of the season, the Palo Alto, Calif., native has posted a .433 batting average (26-for-60) since March 15, covering 16 games played for Kautz. He has five doubles, one triple, three home runs, 13 RBIs and most important, 18 runs scored during the hot stretch. Kautz has posted 10 multi-hit and six multi-run games during the 16 contests as well. He missed three games, at Milligan College and versus Georgetown College, with an

infection on his foot but returned to the lineup as the designated hitter last Friday at Lambuth, collecting a pair of hits and scoring a run in both ends of the doubleheader. He played rightfield in Saturday's contest and at Lee University on Tuesday, going 3-for-4 with one RBI against the Flames. For the season Kautz is batting .386, second best on the club, with six doubles, four home runs, 18 RBIs and 24 runs scored.

Fisher stays consistent

Sophomore Tyler Fisher got off to a slow start at the plate but picked up the pace after the opening two weeks and has continued to build both his average and consistency as the season has progressed. Fisher has hit safely in the last eight games and in 20 of the last 22 contests over the last month. He has seven multi-hit outings during the 22-game stretch and is batting .367 (29-for-75) with seven

doubles, three home runs, 27 RBIs and 16 runs scored. During his current eight game hitting streak, the Kokomo, Ind., native is 11-for-29 (.379) with seven runs scored and eight RBIs with one double and one triple. For the season Fisher is batting .339 with nine doubles, four homers, 20 runs scored and 32 RBIs. He has played all three outfield positions and has just one error in 62 chances this season.

Greener finds longball stroke

Junior Matt Greener is batting .384 (28-for-73) over the past 22 games with six doubles, 13 RBIs and 15 runs scored. He has hit safely in 19 of the 22 contests with eight multi-hit outings. The Jupiter, Fla., native had a big weekend against Lambuth, collecting seven hits in 11 at-bats (.636) with two home runs, one triple, four RBIs and three runs scored. He collected a pair of hits in the first and third games of the series and had three hits in the second contest. Greener entered the series with just one home run for the season but hit one round-tripper in each game of the doubleheader Friday. He badly sprained his ankle in the second contest Friday but still collected a pair of hits and scored once in the series finale. Greener just missed another homer Tuesday at Lee University, driving a ball to the deepest part of the park before Lee's Ross Collins made the catch, hammering the wall in the process. For the season he is batting .370, third best on the club, and leads the Bulldogs with 51 hits. He also has nine doubles, 23 RBIs and 24 runs scored while making starts at five different positions.

Take the good with the bad with Kikla

Junior Sam Kikla started his Bulldog career with 11 hits opening weekend this season then had just three hits over the next six games. Such is an example of the highs and lows of Kikla's first season at CU. The Malabar, Fla., native leads the club with eight home runs, 36 runs scored, 33 RBIs, seven stolen bases and 83 total bases, batting .342, fourth best on the squad. But he also leads the Bulldogs with 27 strikeouts and his streakiness at the plate is currently in a down cycle. Kikla is just 6-for-28 (.214) over the last seven games, though he does have one hit in six of the seven contests, including a solo home run in the first inning last Saturday at Lambuth. The one thing that has not faltered this season has been his defense, where Kikla has committed only four errors in 139 chances.

Mull still drives in runs despite slump

Senior Eric Mull continues to make productive outs despite his current hitting slump where the San Jose, Calif., native is just 4-for-22 (.182) over the last 10 games. Despite the hitting woes, Mull has driven in seven runs during the 10 games, none bigger than a three-run, game-tying home run in the first game Saturday against rival Trevecca, a contest the Bulldogs won in 11 innings. It is Mull's

only extra-base hit during the 10 games as well. For the season he is batting just .215 with four doubles, six home runs, 29 RBIs and 19 runs scored.

Wheeler cools a bit

Senior Michael Wheeler was on fire at the plate for the Bulldogs over a 14-game hitting streak from March 14-April 10, batting .462 with five doubles, two home runs, 15 RBIs and 13 runs scored. The Mt. Juliet, Tenn., native posted seven multi-hit games during the stretch. In the first game of the April 11 doubleheader against Trevecca, Wheeler lined out to deep rightcenter and leftcenter but then had six consecutive bad at-bats to end the series against the Trojans. He may have found his stroke again, as evidenced with a sharp single and a line drive home run Tuesday at Lee University. He has hit safely in the last seven contests, going 9-for-28 (.321) with seven RBIs and four runs scored. For the season Wheeler leads the Bulldogs with a .388 batting average, ranks second on the club with 50 hits and 11 doubles, and also has five home runs, 29 RBIs and 22 runs scored.

Tidbits

Cumberland has used a different starting lineup in each game this season and has used 36 different players in 2009 because of injuries and suspensions ... Clint Alexander has just four hits in his last 14 at-bats, though his single last Saturday at Lambuth drove in the winning run in the sixth inning. Alexander was also 2-for-2 with two runs scored Tuesday at Lee University ... Because of injury and Max Kautz continuing to hit, Zack Diekmann has just one at-bat in the month of April, a pinch-hit strikeout on Friday against Trevecca ... Matt Holliman has just five hits in his last 23 at-bats (.217) spanning eight games, but the junior has drawn eight walks during the stretch, scoring five times. He also has three doubles among his five hits ... Brian Karahalios has just two hits in his last 15 at-bats spanning seven games played, which dates back to March 29 at Lyon College ... Kyle West is 7-for-28 (.250) with four walks over his last nine games, though he did have a two-run double in the finale against Trevecca and two hits last Saturday at Lambuth. West has started 13 of the last 14 games for the Bulldogs behind the plate over the last 21 days heading into Friday's contest at Freed-Hardeman.

Kikla, Sprague named TSAC Player, Pitcher of the Week

Juniors Sam Kikla and Adam Sprague were named the TranSouth Player and Pitcher of the Week, respectively, on April 13 for their performances in last week's victories over ninth-ranked Campbellsville and No. 18 Trevecca. Sprague and TNU's Wesley Griggs shared the Pitcher of the Week honors. Kikla helped the Bulldogs to a 3-1 mark for the week, including a 19-8 victory over Campbellsville and a series win against Trevecca. The junior infielder

belted four home runs during the week, with a pair versus Campbellsville. He also hit a two-run walkout shot in a 7-5, 11-inning triumph in the opening game of a doubleheader Saturday against Trevecca and added a three-run homer in the second game that proved to be the decisive runs. For the week the Malabar, Fla., native was 7-for-18 (.389) with five runs scored, four home runs, 10 RBIs and a walk with a slugging percentage of 1.056. Sprague also played a big role in CU's doubleheader sweep of the Trojans on Saturday, picking up a win and a save in the twinbill. The Winter Park, Fla., native tossed 3.2 hitless innings of relief in the opener to earn the victory after Kikla's walk-off home run. He retired 11 of the 12 batters he faced. In the second game Sprague struck out Brian Dirheimer, the potential winning run, with two runners on in the eighth, and recorded two more strikeouts in the ninth to post his first save of the season.

Kautz, Post selected TSAC POW

Juniors Max Kautz and Robert Post were selected the TranSouth Conference Player and Pitcher of the Week, respectively, March 29 as named by the conference office. Kautz hit .563 during CU's four victories with nine runs scored, three doubles, one home run and five RBIs. He also drew two walks while posting a .938 slugging percentage. The Palo Alto, Calif., native posted at least two hits in all four games for the week. Kautz hit a game-winning two-run homer in the 10-inning, 11-10 victory over Lyon College in the first game of a doubleheader. Post posted a five-inning no-hitter in his only appearance of the week. The Mt. Juliet, Tenn., native struck out eight and walked three against Lyon in the no-hitter and allowed just an unearned run on a throwing error in the contest.

Sprague voted TSAC Pitcher of the Week

Junior Adam Sprague was voted the TranSouth Conference Pitcher of the Week on February 23 after posting his second victory of the season, versus Iowa Wesleyan. The lefthander from Winter Park, Fla., tossed six innings, allowing just two earned runs, striking out six and walking two against the Tigers.

CU ranked 11th in preseason

The Cumberland baseball team ranked 11th in the 2009 NAIA Baseball Coaches' Preseason Top 25 Poll announced in November. The Bulldogs posted a 46-21 record last season and finished the year one win shy of their fifth straight NAIA World Series appearance. The Bulldogs and 28th-year head coach Woody Hunt returned four starters from last year's club, including catcher Mike Wheeler, who hit 15 home runs and had 64 RBIs, as well as outfielder/DH Zack Diekmann, who belted eight home runs with 26 RBIs. CU had to replace almost its entire pitching staff that posted a team earned-run-average of 3.74 last season and allowed

opponents to bat just .258. Gone from roster are eight pitchers who accounted for 75 percent of last season's innings.

Hunt elected to Tennessee

Sports Hall of Fame

Cumberland baseball coach Woody Hunt was be one of 11 greats inducted into the Tennessee Sports Hall of Fame on February 20 at the Renaissance Hotel in Nashville, Tenn. Others who were inducted include Sam Bartholomew, Jr., Philip Hutcheson, Joe Gilliam, Jr. (posthumous), Tommy Owen (posthumous), Andy Nelson, Sarah Ingram, Elliot Perry, Tim Priest, Stan Huntsman and Chip Kell. Hunt has served on the baseball staff at Cumberland for 30 years, three as an assistant in 1978, '79 and '81 and then as the head coach since 1982. CU was a two-year school his first two seasons and became a four-year institution beginning with the 1984 baseball season. The Belmont University graduate has compiled 1,193 victories in 27 seasons as head coach at CU and an 1,132-463-3 mark as head coach since 1984. He is one of only six coaches to register more than 1,000 career victories in NAIA. It marked the fifth Hall of Fame in which Hunt was inducted. He had previously been inducted into the NAIA, Cumberland, Boyle County [KY] and Tennessee Baseball Coaches Association Halls of Fame.

CU picked to win TranSouth

Cumberland's baseball team was picked to win the TranSouth Conference in a preseason poll of the league coaches announced in January by the conference office. Cumberland received six of the eight first-place votes in a poll of the league coaches and tallied 62 total points. Trevecca received the other two first-place votes and had 58 total points for second place. Union University, Martin Methodist and Lyon College ranked third, fourth and fifth, respectively, with Freed-Hardeman, Bethel College and Mid-Continent rounding out the poll. In 2008, Trevecca won the regular season title, with Cumberland taking the TranSouth Tournament championship. The Bulldogs won their fifth straight Region XI Tournament but fell one game shy of the NAIA World Series, losing in a best-of-three series to Union College (KY).

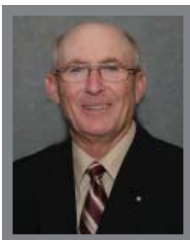

Woody Hunt

Head Coach • Belmont Univ./1980 • 28th Season • 1,215-503-3 (.707) overall



Cumberland University owes a great debt of gratitude to legendary and Hall of Fame head coach Woody Hunt for his great service not only to the baseball program but also to the athletic department

and the University as well as the community of Lebanon.

Hunt begins his 28th season as head coach of the Bulldogs in 2009 and his 31st with the Cumberland program. He has amassed an impressive resume along the way and continues to add to his credentials with each passing year.

But even more importantly Hunt continues to play a major role within the overall landscape of the University as well as in the Lebanon and Wilson County communities where so many of his former players have settled into lives after baseball.

Hunt is one of only six coaches in history to register 1,000 career victories in the NAIA and heads into the '09 season with a 1,193-489-3 overall record. The Bulldogs have appeared in 10

NAIA World Series, including four in the last five seasons, but his most crowning program achievement came when CU claimed the 2004 national championship in Lewiston, Idaho. The Bulldogs have finished as the national runner-up on two other occasions as well, in 1995 and 2006.

Cumberland has won 16 conference championships during Hunt's tenure, including 10 in the Tennessee Collegiate Athletic Conference (TCAC), five in the Mid-South Conference (MSC) and one in the TranSouth Conference (TSAC). CU has four district championships, 11 NAIA regional titles and has played in five super regionals as well.

The program has posted 20 seasons with 40 or more victories, including 16 of the last 17 years, while registering 50 or more wins seven times, all in the last dozen seasons. The 2004 squad set the school-record for victories with 59.

The Bulldogs have produced 51 NAIA All-Americans, including Steve Green, the only three-time All-American in program history. Seventy-two of Hunt's former players have signed professional contracts.

The Bulldogs have posted a 311-120 record

over the last six seasons with five NAIA World Series appearances, one runner-up finish and one national title.

Hunt has also achieved individual success in the awards category, claiming 16 Coach of the Year honors, including the 2006 Rawlings National Coach of the Year award. He is a seven-time Southeast Region Coach of the Year and has also been a finalist for the National Coach of the Year Award four times.

Perhaps his greatest achievement lies in the facilities in which his team plays, practices and dresses. Cumberland has one of the finest baseball facilities in the nation, second to none in the NAIA, with Ernest L. Stockton Field and its 500 chairback seats and state-of-the-art press box, the Benton Jennings Indoor Hitting Complex and the Jeanette C. Rudy Clubhouse.
