**MUSIC CITY GOLF TOURNAMENT TO BENEFIT RONALD MCDONALD HOUSE  
CHARITIES OF NASHVILLE APRIL 26-27, 2009**

NASHVILLE, Tenn. – The 24<sup>th</sup> Annual Music City Golf Tournament presented by Dr Pepper benefiting Ronald McDonald House Charities of Nashville will be held on Sunday, April 26 and Monday, April 27, 2009 in Nashville, Tennessee.

The tournament will be held in a two-day, Sunday and Monday format. On Sunday evening, we will host the Music City Auction and Dinner in the Club Level of LP Field (Home of the Tennessee Titans) with a Songwriter's Showcase featuring Walt Aldridge, Lisa Carver and Wynn Varble. Tickets to the Music City Auction and Dinner are \$50 per person.

Monday's events include a round of golf with a shotgun start at 11am at Gaylord Springs Golf Links complete with breakfast, on-course refreshments and lunch, followed by The Coca-Cola Company 19<sup>th</sup> Hole Cocktail and Awards Reception. Hotel accommodations at the Hilton Nashville Downtown are included for every golfer and transportation will be provided between the Hilton and LP Field for Sunday evening's events. Individual Golfer registration is \$1,300 per player.

The mission of Ronald McDonald House Charities of Nashville is to "keep families close" by providing essential resources and a "home away from home" for families of critically ill children receiving inpatient or outpatient medical care at a Nashville-area hospital. In 2008, the House served more than 500 families. Since opening, the House has served more than 10,100 families and has served families from all 95 counties in Tennessee, 65 counties in Kentucky, 39 other states and 12 foreign countries.

Ronald McDonald House Charities of Nashville also operates a Family Room located at the Monroe Carell Jr. Children's Hospital at Vanderbilt, which is an extension of the House and a place where families can enjoy a quiet respite from corridors and waiting rooms, whether or not they're staying at the Ronald McDonald House. The Family Room serves more than 2,500 visitors per month.
