Involved Parents

The active Hillsboro PTO/PTA organizations are consistently working together as a team with teachers and principals to improve the education of their children. This involvement includes volunteering in the classroom, fund raising activities and contributing through advisory groups such as the Hillsboro Parent Cluster Group.

Preparation

Hillsboro cluster schools prepare their students for college through a combination of varied and rigorous coursework and an array of engaging activities in which students can be involved during their school experience.

Elementary School Programs

The Hillsboro cluster offers the Paideia program at Sylvan Park. Mandarin is offered at Eakin and Julia Green with Percy Priest and Sylvan Park offering Spanish. Glendale offers the only Spanish Immersion program in Tennessee. Hands-on science, technology labs, visual arts, physical education as well as on-site gifted and talented programs are available at our elementary schools.

Middle School Programs

J.T. Moore is a certified IB Middle Years Programme school. West End is an IB Candidate school. Our middle schools are committed to offering advanced academic courses, especially in math, science and language. Band, strings, physical education,

technology and visual arts are offered at both our middle schools. Students may choose to take courses for high school credit. Those students taking high school courses consistently score well on exit exams.

Extended Care

Before and after school care is available at all of our elementary and middle schools.

High School Program

Hillsboro High School, nationally ranked in the top 2% of public high schools by Newsweek Magazine, is a certified IB Diploma Programme school. In addition to the rigorous Diploma Programme, Hillsboro consistently offers as many AP courses as any school in Metro Nashville.

Program Continuity

Spanish Immersion programming that begins in kindergarten for Glendale students is continued at J.T. Moore Middle School. IB Programming at J.T. Moore and West End is continued at Hillsboro High.

Sports

All of our cluster schools participate in award-winning sports, including high school state championship football, middle school city championship football, soccer and track. All TSSAA sports are represented.

Elementary and middle school programs provide after-school clubs which may include ballet, gymnastics, lacrosse, running, soccer, tae kwon do, tennis and yoga.

Co-Curricular Activities

The Hillsboro cluster schools offer a variety of co-curricular activities during and after school including academic clubs, art, choir, fiddle, guitar, knitting, theater, visual arts and the state champion chess club.

Choice

Students from across Nashville may choose to attend a Hillsboro cluster school.

International Baccalaureate Organization (IBO)

The IBO aims to develop inquiring, knowledgeable and caring young people who help to create a better and more peaceful world through intercultural understanding and respect.

The IBO works with schools, governments and international organizations to develop challenging programs of international education and rigorous assessment.
