CORRIDOR STUDY

Broadway/West End Corridor Study meetings scheduled for January 9

NASHVILLE – The Nashville Metropolitan Transit Authority (MTA) will hold two public meetings in January regarding the Broadway/West End Corridor. A transportation study is examining transit options along the busy corridor. This effort is intended to make Metro Nashville more competitive with other cities for federal funding.

The specific area of the study begins at Five Points in East Nashville and extends down Broadway, West End and Harding Road to White Bridge Road.
