Springer a double-double man

Senior Brandon Springer knew he would have to step up his game if the Bulldogs have any chance of winning this season, and the Nashville, Tenn., native has done more than his part, posting five double-doubles in seven contests. Springer has a pair of 30-point outings and posted four straight double-doubles from November 2-18, averaging 26.3 points and 11.3 rebounds per outing during the stretch. He hit 44-for-60 shots from the field during the four games, a whopping 73 percent. For the season the Columbia State CC transfer is averaging 21.0 points and 9.3 rebounds per contest 12th nationally in points per game and 21st in the country in rebounds per outing. Springer also ranks 25th nationally in field goal percentage (.615) and 32nd in steals (13).

Bulldogs' struggles are many

Cumberland's youth and inexperience has led to a number of struggles for the 1-6 Bulldogs, including averaging 22.6 turnovers per game. With three true freshmen and one redshirt freshmen in the starting lineup for the last five games, CU has experienced the ups-and-downs of a young club, losing three close games when they did not execute well down the stretch. Cumberland has also struggled mightily from behind the arc, hitting only 17-of-79 3-pointers this season, a woeful 22 percent. Add in a 57 percent mark at the foul line, and points have been at a definite premium. The Bulldogs averaged more than 76 points per game last season but are just below 70 so far in 2009-10. Four of the team's six losses are by a combined 20 points, including three

home defeats by a combined 14 points.

Simon steps up his game

Freshmen Walter Simon was thrust into the starting lineup by head coach Lonnie Thompson because of his unique skill set that includes a soft touch around the basket and good footwork. The Dresden, Germany, native has started all seven contests so far this season and is the only other Bulldog besides Brandon Springer to average in double figures. Simon is netting 11.4 points per game on 62 percent shooting from the field and is also grabbing 5.9 rebounds per outing, second best on the club behind Springer as well. He scored in double figures in four straight games from November 10-20, including 19 points and seven boards in a 69-68 loss to Talladega College on Nov. 18.

Williamson goes through ups and downs

Freshman Adrian Williamson has experienced the highs and lows of college basketball in the early going this season, scoring in double figures four times in seven contests but also posting zero points once and just one point in another game. Williamson is third on the club in scoring at 9.6 points per game. The Nashville, Tenn., native scored 20 points against Hiwassee College and 19 against Fisk Univ., but was held scoreless in the season opener at Oakwood Univ. and netted just one point last Friday versus St. Catharine College, going 0-for-6 from the field. He came back with 10 points in Saturday's loss to Evangel Univ.

Youth is served

Eighth-year Cumberland head coach Lonnie Thompson may have to perform the best coaching job of his career in 2009-10, as the Bulldogs return just one player from last season's 26-5 club, senior Brandon Springer. Cumberland graduated seven seniors and saw five others leave the program after the season or during the summer. Thompson has five transfers along with four true freshmen on this year's squad, along with Haris Batalevic, who enrolled at CU in the spring and redshirted. Batalevic along with freshman Walter Simon (Dresden, Germany) and juniors Andrew Ayodeji (Amityville, N.Y./Columbia State CC) and Reginald Holding (Newark, N.J./Essex County College) will be the top newcomers for CU this season. Lamar Brinkley, a transfer who redshirted at Western Kentucky last season, and 6-foot-8, 290-pound Michael Pettiford, a transfer from Shawnee CC, should also see plenty of action for the Bulldogs.

Van Buren joins the club

Redshirt sophomore Jimmy Van Buren joined the Bulldogs two weeks ago, giving Cumberland another big body under the basket. His arrival coincided with an injury to forward Reginald Holding, who is out indefinitely while doctors determine whether the junior needs surgery. Van Buren arrived in Lebanon this fall as a pitcher for the baseball team and will continue in that role for coach Woody Hunt in the spring. The 6-foot-10, 270-pounder from Dahlongega, Ga., attended Calhoun CC in Decatur, Ala. the last two years.

Former Belmont star Collins joins staff

Former Belmont Univ. point guard Brian Collins is the new assistant coach for the Bulldogs in 2009-10. Jeremy Lewis, head coach Lonnie Thompson's assist the past four seasons, is now the women's head coach at Cumberland. Collins joined the Bulldog staff after spending the last two seasons as a graduate assistant and Director of Basketball Operations at Tennessee

State. The Nashville native played for coach Rick Byrd at Belmont from 2003-06, helping the Bruins compile a 72-48 four-year record, including the program's first-ever NIT appearance in 2004 and the school's first NCAA Tournament appearance in 2006. He still holds several records at Belmont during the school's NCAA era, including ranking first in career assists (452) and steals (178), tied for first in free throw attempts (466), fourth in free throws made (293), fifth in rebounding (489), and seventh in scoring (1,199) and field goals attempted (942).

Last year against the Blue Raiders

Kenneth Simms led three double-figure scorers with 19 points and Cumberland hung tough throughout, but the 19th-ranked Bulldogs lost 81-70 in an exhibition contest versus Middle Tennessee in Murfreesboro on November 1 of

last season. It was the third game in three days for Cumberland. Simms added six rebounds, four blocks and three steals for the Bulldogs. Rontreal Braxton scored 13 points with eight boards and Brandon Springer netted 11 points for CU, which shot 49 percent from the floor, including 6-of-16 from 3-point range. The Bulldogs trailed just 45-36 at halftime despite shooting better than 50 percent, but turned the ball over 13 times. CU cut the deficit as close as seven points eight minutes into the second half after Springer hit two of his six free throws in the contest, but the Bulldogs could not get closer. The Blue Raiders used a 15-6 run over final minutes late in the half to extend the lead to as many as 19. Desmond Yates, the Sun Belt Preseason Player of the Year, scored 27 points for Middle Tennessee, while Nigel Johnson added 13 and Kevin Kanaskie had 10.

Springer voted Preseason All-TSAC

Senior Brandon Springer was voted to the Preseason All-TranSouth Conference Team in a vote of TranSouth coaches announced in October at the league's Media Day in Jackson, Tenn. Springer averaged a team-best 13.3 points and 6.9 rebounds per game last season for a squad that had five players average double figures. The Nashville, Tenn., native earned Honorable Mention All-America honors in 2008-09 and helped the Bulldogs reach the NAIA National Tournament for the second straight season and the third time in six years. Springer posted six double-doubles last season and scored in double digits in 24 of the team's 31 contests. Fourteen of his double-figure scoring games along with five of his double-doubles came against TranSouth competition. The Hunters Lane High School product also averaged 1.2 assists and 1.9 steals per game and finished 11th in the TranSouth in scoring, third in steals and seventh in rebounds.

Cumberland picked fifth in preseason

The Cumberland men's basketball team was picked fifth in a vote of TranSouth coaches announced in October at the league's Media Day in Jackson, Tenn. The Bulldogs return just one letterwinner from last season's 25-6 club that earned an at-large berth into the NAIA National Tournament, senior Brandon Springer. CU tied for second in last year's conference standings with a 13-3 mark, including a pair of overtime losses. Union University, last year's regular season conference champion, received 73 points to

Head Coach Lonnie Thompson



Cumberland's Lonnie Thompson begins his eighth season with the Bulldogs and his 12th as a head coach. Thompson's program has enjoyed unprecedented success, making its third NAIA National Tournament appearance

last season in the last six years, the only national tournament appearances in program history.

Last year's club was the first in program history to make back-to-back national tournament appearances. The Bulldogs also posted their second straight 20-plus win campaign and third in the last six seasons, all coinciding with trips to Kansas City.

The Woodbury, Ga., native has posted a 129-95 mark at Cumberland with one TranSouth Conference regular season championship. Thompson posted his 200th career head coach victory last season as well, February 19 at Lambuth University, in just his 11th year as a head coach.

Thompson came to CU from Motlow State Community College in Tullahoma, Tenn., where he led the Bucks to back-to-back TJCCAA Eastern Division Championships. He was named TJCCAA Eastern Division Coach of the Year three times at Motlow State and was the unanimous selection for 2004 TranSouth Coach of the Year in just his second season in the conference.

That season, he led the Bulldogs to the most wins in school history with a 28-6 record. The 2004



season also saw Thompson capture his 100th career victory as a head coach en route to leading the Bulldogs to the first TranSouth Conference Championship in school history. The program also made the school's first-ever appearance at the NAIA National Tournament in Kansas City, Mo., where they were defeated in the Round of 16.

Cumberland posted a 21-12 overall mark in 2007-08 and made its second appearance in the NAIA National Tournament, falling to Oklahoma City in the first round.

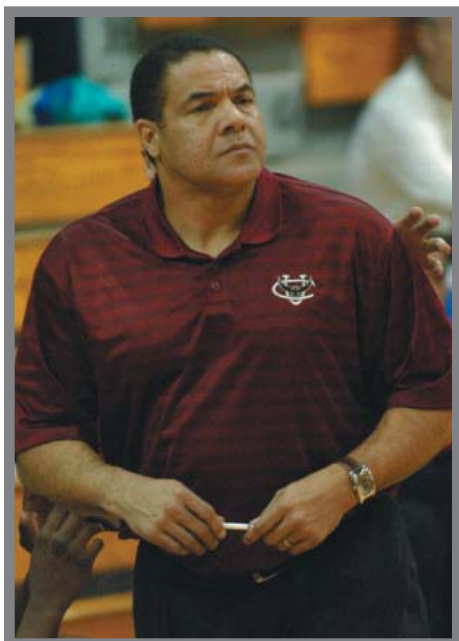
Thompson has a depth of coaching experi-

ence at all levels of college basketball, serving as an assistant coach at South Alabama, Middle Tennessee, Tennessee State, Creighton and Odessa Junior College, where he coached former NBA All-Star Larry Johnson.

Lonnie and his wife, Felicia, have two sons, Destin and Darius, and one daughter, Devin, and the family resides in Murfreesboro, Tenn. Thompson received his bachelor's from Middle Tennessee in 1986 and returned to his alma mater as an assistant coach under David Farrar in the mid-90's.
