A Celebration of the Life of Rusty Groves

Although she was named **Dorothy Ellen Ruston** at birth (Sept. 4, 1923 in Booneville, Indiana) and was called “Aunt Dot” by her sister’s children, for the rest of her life she would be known by virtually everyone as “**Rusty Groves**.” In fact, a sign reminded her caregivers, “Call me ‘Rusty.’”
