

# VALLEY VIEW MEDICAL CENTER

**Fort Mohave, Arizona**

(Population: 15,709 • Service area: 64,133)

Located on the eastern banks of the Colorado River, near the juncture of Arizona, Nevada and California, Fort Mohave is a thriving, bustling community that offers mild winters, year-round sunshine and a host of water recreation opportunities.



## THE HOSPITAL

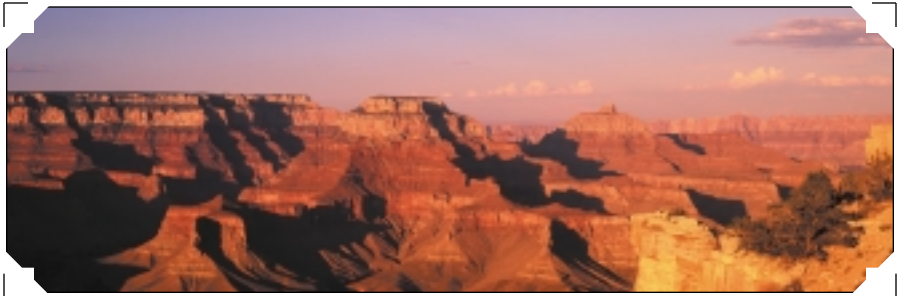
Opened in late 2005, Valley View Medical Center is a 102,000-square-foot acute-care facility with an adjacent 20,000-square-ft. medical office building. The hospital features 60 beds: 38 med/surg beds, ten rehabilitation beds, a six-bed labor & delivery unit, and a six-bed intensive care unit. There are four major operating rooms and two minor procedure rooms. The hospital provides 24-hour emergency service with full-time emergency physicians on duty. The facility offers a full complement of community and regional referral services in all of the major medical disciplines, with a medical staff that represents a broad cross section of specialty areas.



Located just minutes away from I-40, Fort Mohave also provides easy access to the city life offered by the metropolitan areas of Phoenix, Las Vegas and Los Angeles.

## RECREATION

The Mohave Valley and Tri-state region is a true paradise for water sports and other outdoor activities. Swimming, boating, scuba diving and skiing, as well as trophy fishing for bass, trout, and other species, are available at several locations throughout the region. Only four miles across



at its widest point, but 67 miles in length, **Lake Mohave** features 237 miles of shoreline that can be enjoyed year-round. The lake's surrounding terrain includes sheer cliffs, sandy beaches and secluded coves. Nearby **Lake Havasu** is a 45-mile long water recreation paradise. Finally, the Colorado River provides hundreds of miles of navigable water, while the spectacular views of the **Grand Canyon** (above) and the beautiful cities of Flagstaff and Sedona are only a few hours away.



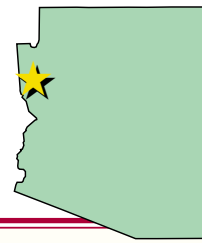
## THE COMMUNITY

Located along the Colorado River, the Mohave Valley is one of the fastest growing areas in the United States. The community features a classic low-desert climate, with extremely low humidity, smog-free air, sunshine almost every day of the year and breathtakingly beautiful sunsets most every evening. The average daily high temperature in November is 74 degrees.

## Local Points of Interest

- **Grand Canyon National Park** – one of America's most breathtaking natural wonders is just two hours away.
- **Mohave National Preserve** – a natural wonder offering a vast variety of desert scenes and wildlife.
- **Colorado River Recreation Area** – extends 650 miles from Yuma, Arizona to Lake Powell and features the very best in boating, fishing and water sports.

Other recreational activities offered by the region include hiking, off-road vehicle sports and hunting. For nature lovers, nearby **Mohave National Preserve**, created by Congress in 1994, has 1.6 million acres of protected desert

habitat. Located in the heart of the world famous **Mojave Desert**, this beautiful and tranquil setting showcases a wide variety of natural features, including rose-colored sand dunes, Joshua tree forests and mile-high mountains. Four-wheel-drive vehicles are welcomed to explore an extensive network of dirt roads. East of the city, **The Black Mountain Range** has plenty of possibilities to go off-roading or to explore ghost towns. Hunters can find mule deer, quail, dove and bighorn sheep.

Golf is another popular outdoor activity in the region. No less than six courses are within easy driving distance of Fort Mohave, including Desert Lakes Golf Course, with a 6,569-yard, par 72 layout. Entertainment is a major area attraction, just across the Colorado River, in Laughlin, NV (above left).
