**Eaton Marks Completion of Fifth Habitat Home  
With Key Presentation to the Kushtan Family**

*ASHEVILLE, N.C. (April 29, 2010)* – On Thursday, May 6 at 12 noon, Eaton Corporation will celebrate the completion of its fifth Habitat house in Buncombe County. This year, company representatives will present ceremonial keys to the Kushtan family, in the Enka Hills neighborhood.

Eaton is a strong partner with Habitat, providing not only funding but also volunteers to help build the homes they sponsor. Eaton also supports Asheville Area Habitat on an ongoing basis, with in-kind donations of electrical products used in house construction. The local Eaton plant has submitted a grant request to the corporation in hopes of sponsoring its sixth Habitat house in the coming year.
