Notes: Cumberland heads to Nashville to take on rival Trevecca Nazarene with first place in the TranSouth Conference on the line in the early going. Cumberland leads the series against rival TNU, 13-9, over the last six seasons, including four series victories against the Trojans. CU won last year's series, 2-1, in Lebanon and has series victories in 2005, 2006 and 2007, all 2-1. TNU won the 2008 series 2-0. The Bulldogs are just 2-4 at Jackson Field over the last six years.

Greener, Wilkerson named POW

Senior Matt Greener and junior Aaron Wilkerson were named the TranSouth Conference Player and Pitcher of the Week, respectively, on Monday after helping the Bulldogs to a 3-1 record last week, including a pair of victories over No. 13 Bethel University. Greener and Trevecca Nazarene's Chris Hale were named Co-Players of the Week. It was Greener's third consecutive Player of the Week honor and fourth this season from the TranSouth. Cumberland has now claimed 10 of the 14 league POW accolades this season. Greener continued his assault on opponent pitching, collecting eight hits in 13 at-bats (.615) with three home runs, seven RBIs and six runs scored. The Jupiter, Fla., native went 3-for-4 with two home runs and four RBIs in a 12-10 victory over Lambuth Univ. and recorded five hits with a double, one home run, three RBIs and four runs scored in three games versus Bethel. His three-run homer in the fourth inning of Friday's doubleheader opener against Bethel proved to be a game-winner. Wilkerson tossed a one-hit shutout in Friday's second game versus Bethel, allowing just three baserunners with four strikeouts in the five-inning victory. The righthander walked one and hit a batter while throwing only 68 pitches. The Waco, Texas, native is now 5-1 this season with a 1.93 ERA and 46 strikeouts in 37.1 innings of work. The righthander has victories this season over Oklahoma City Univ., Embry-Riddle, Union Univ. and Bethel.

Bulldogs move up to No. 3

Cumberland moved up one spot to third in this week's NAIA Baseball Coaches' Top 25 Poll released Tuesday. The Bulldogs jumped 15 spots and were ranked fourth nationally in the first regular season 2010 poll released March 30 by the national office. The ranking is the highest for

the Bulldogs since earning the second spot in the preseason poll in 2007. The Bulldogs already have nine victories this season over ranked opponents - three versus No. 3 Oklahoma City Univ., two against seventh-ranked Embry-Riddle and No. 13 Bethel Univ., and one versus eighth-ranked Campbellsville Univ. and No. 8 Lee Univ. Cumberland also still has 20th-ranked Milligan College on its schedule on April 27. CU won 2-of-3 over 19th-ranked Union Univ. two weekends ago as well. Cumberland was ranked 19th in the NAIA Baseball Coaches' Top 25 Preseason Poll released in November.

Appleton likes the top spot

Junior Greg Appleton has been one of the team's hottest hitters over the last two-plus weeks, posting a season-best nine-game hitting streak and moving into a new spot in the order, the leadoff position. The Port Coquitlam, British Columbia, native has hit in the leadoff spot the last three games, going 6-for-15 (.400) with three doubles, one home run, one walk, four RBIs, four runs scored and just two strikeouts. Appleton doubled twice and hit a three-run homer in Tuesday's 17-16 victory over No. 8 Lee Univ. During his current nine-game hitting streak, the first baseman is batting .455 (15-for-33) with six doubles, three home runs, 11 RBIs and 10 runs scored. He has raised his batting average 63 points during the stretch and is now batting .357 with eight doubles, nine home runs, 28 RBIs and 26 runs scored after batting eighth for most of the year.

Greener's stats are stunning

Senior Matt Greener has been nothing short of amazing this season, putting up offensive numbers that currently lead the nation in five categories and rank in the Top 10 in five others. The Jupiter, Fla., native has hit safely in 36

of the team's 37 contests and currently has a 25-game hitting streak, batting .510 (49-for-96) with 10 doubles, 13 home runs, 41 RBIs and 28 runs scored during the stretch. Greener has earned four TranSouth Conference Player of the Week accolades, including three straight. He has multiple hits in 20 contests and multiple RBIs in 13 games, both team highs. Greener currently leads the nation in home runs (16), RBIs (56), slugging percentage (.970), total bases (129) and total bases per game while ranking third in hits (65) and home runs per game, fifth in RBIs per game, seventh in hits per game and ninth in batting average (.489).

Schaefer stays perfect

Senior Shawn Schaefer posted his seventh victory in seven outings this season in a 3-2 victory

over No. 13 Bethel Univ. in last Friday's double-header opener. The lefthander was not as sharp as in previous outings, but nonetheless battled enough to keep his record perfect this season. Schaefer allowed two runs on seven hits while striking out seven. The Pitt Meadows, British Columbia, native has a 1.09 ERA and 50 strikeouts in 49.2 innings of work. He has allowed just nine total runs, six earned, in the seven outings, and has victories over North Alabama, Missouri Baptist, Oklahoma City Univ., Embry-Riddle, Union Univ. and Bethel. He is ranked in the Top 12 nationally in 10 categories, including fourth in ERA, fifth in victories and sixth in total runs allowed (9) and total earned runs allowed (6).

Kikla still does it all

Senior Sam Kikla has been a model of consis-

tency in 2010, continuing his all-around play offensively and improving his body of work on defense as well. Kikla led the Bulldogs in nine offensive categories last season and while he's not doing that this year, his numbers are helping the Bulldogs to more victories. The Malabar, Fla., native currently ranks third nationally in runs scored with 51 and sixth in runs scored per game. He is batting .378 with seven doubles, nine home runs and 38 RBIs and also has the team lead with 21 walks and 10 stolen bases. He has also been hit nine times and has a .497 on-base percentage, second best on the club. Kikla has also been very solid at shortstop, making just eight errors in 158 chances this season and using his athleticism to his advantage.

Post looks better in relief

Senior Robert Post tossed four innings of relief in last Saturday's loss to Bethel Univ. in his longest

outing since February 27 against Viterbo Univ. Post allowed just two hits and struck out four and overall had his best outing since missing 17 days with a shoulder injury. He struck out four in 1.2 innings of relief to get the victory in Tuesday's victory over No. 8 Lee Univ., giving up just one hit. The Mt. Juliet, Tenn., native tossed a three-hit shutout against the Univ. of St. Francis in his first start of the year but was not as sharp in the outing versus Viterbo and then left after an inning on March 6 at Oklahoma City Univ. He tossed one inning of relief versus Campbellsville Univ. on March 23 and then had a start at Union Univ. in the first TranSouth series, but allowed six runs on nine hits in 3.2 innings. For the season Post is now 3-2 with a 3.33 ERA and 23 strikeouts in 24.1 innings of work.

Wilkerson good compliment to Schaefer

Junior Aaron Wilkerson continues to live up to his billing as one of the top pitchers in the nation after winning his fifth straight game in a one-hit shutout against No. 13 Bethel Univ. last Friday. The righthander lowered his ERA to 1.93 and now has 46 strikeouts in 37.1 innings of work. Wilkerson was as sharp as he has been all season against Bethel, giving up one single, a walk and hitting a batter. He has allowed just eight earned runs all season while posting victories over Oklahoma City Univ., Embry-Riddle, Union Univ. and Bethel.

Fanshawe finds his stroke

Even after Wednesday's 0-for-4 effort at Campbellsville Univ., junior David Fanshawe has found the hitting groove again after slumping in the middle of March. The Miami, Fla., native went through a 3-for-23 (.130) skid from March

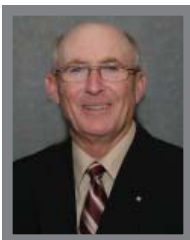

Woody Hunt

Head Coach • Belmont Univ./1980 • 29th Season • 1,255-522-3 (.706) overall



Cumberland University owes a great debt of gratitude to legendary and Hall of Fame head coach Woody Hunt for his great service not only to the baseball program but also to the athletic department and the University as well as the community of Lebanon.

Hunt begins his 28th season as head coach of the Bulldogs in 2009 and his 31st with the Cumberland program. He has amassed an impressive resume along the way and continues to add to his credentials with each passing year.

But even more importantly Hunt continues to play a major role within the overall landscape of the University as well as in the Lebanon and Wilson County communities where so many of his former players have settled into lives after baseball.

Hunt is one of only six coaches in history to register 1,000 career victories in the NAIA and heads into the '09 season with a 1,193-489-3 overall record. The Bulldogs have appeared in 10 NAIA World Series, including four in the last five seasons, but his most crowning program achievement came when CU claimed the 2004 national championship in Lewiston, Idaho. The Bulldogs have finished as the national runner-up on two other occasions, in 1995 and 2006.

Cumberland has won 16 conference championships during Hunt's tenure, including 10 in the Tennessee

Collegiate Athletic Conference (TCAC), five in the Mid-South Conference (MSC) and one in the TranSouth Conference (TSAC). CU has four district championships, 11 NAIA regional titles and has played in five super regionals as well.

The program has posted 20 seasons with 40 or more victories, including 16 of the last 17 years, while registering 50 or more wins seven times, all in the last dozen seasons. The 2004 squad set the school-record for victories with 59.

The Bulldogs have produced 51 NAIA All-Americans, including Steve Green, the only three-time All-American in program history. Seventy-two of Hunt's former players have signed professional contracts.

The Bulldogs have posted a 311-120 record over the last six seasons with five NAIA World Series appearances, one runner-up finish and one national title.

Hunt has also achieved individual success in the awards category, claiming 16 Coach of the Year honors, including the 2006 Rawlings National Coach of the Year award. He is a seven-time Southeast Region Coach of the Year and has also been a finalist for the National Coach of the Year Award four times.

Perhaps his greatest achievement lies in the facilities in which his team plays, practices and dresses. Cumberland has one of the finest baseball facilities in the nation, second to none in the NAIA, with Ernest L. Stockton Field and its 500 chairback seats and state-of-the-art press box, the Benton Jennings Indoor Hitting Complex and the Jeanette C. Rudy Clubhouse.
