Episcopal Relief and Development Sunday raises \$475

Members donated \$475 on March 8, ERD Sunday. The funds went to the Millennium Development Goals Inspiration Fund providing prevention measures for spread of malaria; clean water, sanitation services and hygiene education to prevent illness; education to prevent the spread of HIV; smokeless stoves to eliminate respiratory illness; information for local health workers in remote communities; and nutrition and education for pregnant women and new born babies.
