

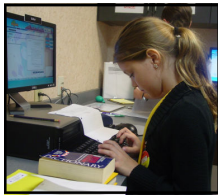
The Experience

Important Info

Registration: To ensure a valuable experience for all participants, JA BizTown Summer Camp is limited to 70 campers per week, so early registration is encouraged. Our website will reflect current availability.

Payments and Refunds: Payment is due upon registration.

Make checks payable to "Junior Achievement of Middle Tennessee." There are no refunds for illness or missed days due to vacation.

If you cancel your registration before May 1, 2012, you will receive a full refund less a \$50 processing fee. If you cancel your registration after May 1, 2012, there is no refund.

Lunch: Each camper needs to bring a sack lunch daily. Junior Achievement provides a drink and a snack each day.

Appropriate Dress: Campers should dress modestly, comfortably, and appropriately. There will be some active games and lessons, so athletic shoes are recommended.

Medication: If your child has medication that must be dispensed during the camp day, please send all medication to camp in a large zip-lock bag clearly marked with your child's name. All medication should be in the original container with a signed parental note, which clearly states dispensing directions.

Extended Day: Extended Day is available from 7:30 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. for an additional fee of \$60 per week. There will be a late fee of \$1.00 per minute for pick up after 5:30 p.m.

A \$20 fee per morning or afternoon will be charged to all parents deciding to use extended day services (7:30-8:45 a.m. and/or 3:30-5:30 p.m.) on an "as needed" day-to-day basis.
