The Bulldogs have won 6-of-7 on the current homestand, including a pair of victories over sixth-ranked Embry-Riddle ... CU is 13-2 at home this season and have outscored opponents 124-37 at home in 2010, an average of 8.3-2.5 ... Davenport heads into Friday's game versus Marian Univ. with a 6-10 overall record.

Schaefer stays sharp

Senior Shawn Schaefer posted his fourth consecutive victory in as many outings on Monday with a jewel of a performance in a complete game against sixth-ranked Embry-Riddle. The lefthander allowed just four hits and struck out a season-high 12 in a 3-1 CU triumph. Schaefer walked one and gave up one run in the nine-inning affair. The Pitt Meadows, British Columbia, native faced more than four batters in an inning just once, in the seventh when the Eagles scored their lone run. Schaefer lowered his ERA to 1.26 for the season and has 26 strikeouts in 28.2 innings of work this season.

Greener keeps on hittin'

Senior Matt Greener has been the epitome of consistency this season for the Bulldogs and has put up power numbers in line with what the club expected when he signed out of Palm Beach CC. The Jupiter, Fla., native has hit safely in 23 of the team's 24 contests this season and has multiple hits in 11 outings. Greener also has seven home runs and 30 RBIs, one more than his RBI total for all of 2009 and almost doubling his home run output (4). He collected five hits with a double, two runs scored and three RBIs in the series against Embry-Riddle and added three hits with a home run and double as well as two runs scored and four RBIs in Wednesday's triumph over Georgetown College. Greener is now batting .451, second best on the club, with a team-high 10 doubles as well as 25 runs scored.

Wilkerson backs up Schaefer

With the injury to senior Robert Post, junior Aaron Wilkerson has stepped into the vacant spot in the rotation and been superb, defeating third-ranked Oklahoma City Univ. and No. 6 Embry-Riddle in his last two starts. Both were superior efforts,

striking out 12 at OCU and giving up just three hits with nine strikeouts versus ERAU. The righthander lowered his ERA to 2.05 in 26.1 innings of work with 35 strikeouts and just five walks while allowing only 20 hits.

Miller is red hot

Senior Kris Miller struggled through the first few games of the season, but the New Caney, Texas, native has become one of the Bulldogs hottest hitters, raising his batting average almost 250 points over the last two-plus weeks. Miller was hitting .125 after an 0-for-3 performance against Missouri Baptist on February 27, but since then has batted .403 (27-for-67) with 16 extra-base hits, 24 RBIs and 22 runs scored. He has hit safely in 17 of the last 18 contests and has been especially torrid at the plate over the last seven games, hitting .542 (13-for-24) with four doubles, three home runs, nine runs scored and nine RBIs. Miller leads the Bulldogs with eight home runs, ranks second with eight doubles and 28 RBIs and is tied for third with 25 runs scored.

Post set for return

Senior Robert Post was very sharp in his opening start of the season, tossing a three-hit shutout with six strikeouts against the Univ. of St. Francis. He was not as sharp in his second outing, giving up four unearned runs and seven hits in a victory over Viterbo Univ., but the Mt. Juliet, Tenn., native lasted just one inning against Oklahoma City Univ. on March 6 before leaving with an injury. He gave up three runs on three hits to No. 3 OCU, taking the loss in a 10-7 defeat. Post has not pitched since but is set to return this weekend against Davenport Univ. His start Sunday will help determine the Bulldogs rotation heading into next weekend's TranSouth Conference series opener at Union Univ.

Fanshawe picking up his efforts

Junior David Fanshawe has been a steady influence at the plate as well as behind the dish this season for the Bulldogs, posting a .356 batting average and helping the pitching staff register a very respectable 3.17 ERA. The Miami, Fla., native has eight multiple hit games this season, including three in the last four outings, along with six doubles and 15 RBIs. He went 2-for-4 in each of the first two games against sixth-ranked Embry-Riddle and added a pair of hits and a two-run double in Wednesday's 17-7 triumph over Georgetown College. The Bulldog pitching staff has also been a major beneficiary of Fanshawe's efforts, with CU allowing two runs or less in 10 games and giving up seven hits or less in 11 contests already this season.

Frazier keeps it steady

Senior Troy Frazier leads the Bulldogs in home runs this season with 10, but more importantly has been getting on base in front of Kris Miller and Matt Greener, with Frazier scoring runs for CU. The Louisville, Ky., native ranks second on the club with 26 runs scored and 34 hits as well as third in walks with 12. His .500 on-base percentage is first among everyday starters and second only to the .560 mark posted by Brian Karahalios. Frazier has been especially hot over the last 12 games, batting .511 (23-for-45) with eight home runs, 14 RBIs and 14 runs scored. He is batting .420 overall this season, third best on the club, and has 13 extra-base hits, ranking second for the Bulldogs.

Kikla comes out of mini slump

Senior Sam Kikla led Cumberland in nine offensive categories last season and started this season very hot at the plate, batting .439 (18-for-41) with five home runs, 16 RBIs and 21 runs scored through the first 13 games of the season. But the Malabar, Fla., native suffered through a mini slump over the next eight contests, collecting just four hits in 27 at-bats (.148), though he continued to hit the ball hard, just with some bad luck. Kikla has come out of that slump over the last three games, going 7-for-12 (.583) with one homer, five RBIs and four runs scored in the doubleheader split with sixth-ranked Embry-Riddle and Wednesday's victory over Georgetown College. For the season Kikla is batting .363 with a team-best 32 runs scored as well as 26 RBIs and 14 walks.

Kirby set for first start

Redshirt sophomore Keith Kirby will make his first start of the season Saturday against Davenport Univ. after four very effective relief appearances for the Bulldogs thus far this season. The right-hander has a 0.63 ERA in 14.1 innings of work, allowing one earned run with 16 strikeouts. The Lafayette, Tenn., native has posted three really good outings in a row, giving up one earned run in four innings at third-ranked Oklahoma City Univ. and then tossing 6.2 innings at Oklahoma Baptist and allowing two unearned runs with eight strikeouts. He tossed 2.2 scoreless innings Tuesday this week against sixth-ranked Embry-Riddle as well.

Tidbits

Cumberland is 16-0 this season when leading after six innings, a tribute to the starters and their ability to finish games and also to a good relief staff that has posted a 2-1 record with three saves and a 2.47 ERA ... Cumberland has scored in double figures nine times this season, posting an 8-1 record in those games, and has posted double-digit hits in 14 contests, going 12-2 in those outings ... Cumberland pitchers have 11 complete games so far in 2010 and have allowed two runs or fewer in 10 contests. The Bulldogs have also given up seven hits or less in a game 11 times this season ... Senior Max Kautz was moved down in the lineup in Wednesday's game against Georgetown College and responded with a pair of hits with three RBIs and three runs scored. It was just his second multi-hit game since February 20 and only the fourth of the season. He is now hitting .250 with 20 runs scored and 14 RBIs in 22 contests. The Palo Alto, Calif., native started the 2009 campaign very slowly as

well, batting just .281 through the first 21 games of the year. Kautz rebounded last year, posting a .458 batting average over the final 27 contests of the season ... Senior Dave Weyer has been on base eight times over the last six games and has added a pair of sacrifice bunts as well. The Oak Lawn, Ill., native's batting average has gone from .167 to .233 during the same stretch with a pair of doubles, three RBIs and three runs scored.

Schaefer named Pitcher of the Week

Senior Shawn Schaefer was named TranSouth Conference Pitcher of the Week March 8 after his work in a victory at third-ranked Oklahoma City Univ. The Pitt Meadows, British Columbia, native allowed two unearned runs and just six hits to the Stars while striking out eight. He won the TSAC Pitcher of the Week accolade on March 1 as well after shutting out Missouri Baptist.

Bulldogs sweep TranSouth honors

Cumberland seniors Troy Frazier and Shawn Schaefer were named the TranSouth Conference Player and Pitcher of the Week on March 1 after their performances against Missouri Baptist and Viterbo University. Frazier went 9-for-14 (.643) in four games with one double, two home runs, seven runs scored and 11 RBIs. The Louisville, Ky., native collected seven hits and a pair of homers in Sunday's doubleheader sweep of Viterbo, including a solo shot in the first game and a grand slam to end the second contest. Schaefer tossed a one-hit shutout against Missouri Baptist on Saturday, giving up a single in the top of the first and not another hit the rest of the way. The Pitt Meadows, British Columbia, native retired the side in order in the second, third, fourth and seventh innings and walked one batter in both

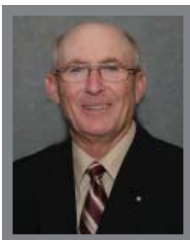

Woody Hunt

Head Coach • Belmont Univ./1980 • 29th Season • 1,244-519-3 (.705) overall



Cumberland University owes a great debt of gratitude to legendary and Hall of Fame head coach Woody Hunt for his great service not only to the baseball program but also to the athletic department and the University as well as the community of Lebanon.

Hunt begins his 28th season as head coach of the Bulldogs in 2009 and his 31st with the Cumberland program. He has amassed an impressive resume along the way and continues to add to his credentials with each passing year.

But even more importantly Hunt continues to play a major role within the overall landscape of the University as well as in the Lebanon and Wilson County communities where so many of his former players have settled into lives after baseball.

Hunt is one of only six coaches in history to register 1,000 career victories in the NAIA and heads into the '09 season with a 1,193-489-3 overall record. The Bulldogs have appeared in 10 NAIA World Series, including four in the last five seasons, but his most crowning program achievement came when CU claimed the 2004 national championship in Lewiston, Idaho. The Bulldogs have finished as the national runner-up on two other occasions, in 1995 and 2006.

Cumberland has won 16 conference championships during Hunt's tenure, including 10 in the Tennessee

Collegiate Athletic Conference (TCAC), five in the Mid-South Conference (MSC) and one in the TranSouth Conference (TSAC). CU has four district championships, 11 NAIA regional titles and has played in five super regionals as well.

The program has posted 20 seasons with 40 or more victories, including 16 of the last 17 years, while registering 50 or more wins seven times, all in the last dozen seasons. The 2004 squad set the school-record for victories with 59.

The Bulldogs have produced 51 NAIA All-Americans, including Steve Green, the only three-time All-American in program history. Seventy-two of Hunt's former players have signed professional contracts.

The Bulldogs have posted a 311-120 record over the last six seasons with five NAIA World Series appearances, one runner-up finish and one national title.

Hunt has also achieved individual success in the awards category, claiming 16 Coach of the Year honors, including the 2006 Rawlings National Coach of the Year award. He is a seven-time Southeast Region Coach of the Year and has also been a finalist for the National Coach of the Year Award four times.

Perhaps his greatest achievement lies in the facilities in which his team plays, practices and dresses. Cumberland has one of the finest baseball facilities in the nation, second to none in the NAIA, with Ernest L. Stockton Field and its 500 chairback seats and state-of-the-art press box, the Benton Jennings Indoor Hitting Complex and the Jeanette C. Rudy Clubhouse.
