

MAINE FLY FISHING

Domestic: 4 people | 4 nights



Serious fishermen know the waters of the North Maine Woods offer some of the best fly fishing in the country. That's what four people will find when they travel to **Libby Camps** in Ashland, Maine, for four days of fly fishing at the Orvis "Fly Fishing Lodge of the Year for 2006." The Libby family started the camp more than 100 years ago on an island in the middle of Millinocket Lake. Among its guests have been Teddy Roosevelt and Jack Dempsey. In 1938 some of the original cabins were relocated to the current site on the lake shoreline and new cabins were added. Since its beginning, Libby Camps has developed modern facilities without sacrificing its rustic charm or reputation for excellent fishing. Native landlocked salmon and trophy brook trout fishing is superb from ice-out to the end of September. Accommodations are in a private lakeside log cabin. The cabin has two bedrooms with two separate beds in each room and a private bath. Your four night visit includes three home-cooked meals daily. Boats, canoes, and kayaks are also provided. Guides, sea plane flights, and outfit rentals are available for a fee.
