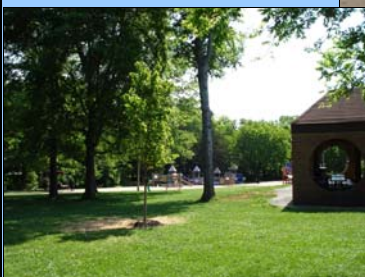

Camp Summer Escape

Camp Summer Escape is a half-day camp for children ages 5-10. Camp takes place at the Delmas Long Community Center and at Moss-Wright Park during the months of June and July from 9:00am to 1:00pm. Each week has a theme and activities are based around the theme. Camp will meet at the Delmas Long Community Center on Monday, Wednesday and Fridays and at Moss-Wright Park on Tuesday and Thursday. Camp is limited to 20 kids and is staffed by well-qualified recreation professionals who are caring, adventurous, and passionate about what they do. Kids will experience a great summer with new games, sports, arts and crafts, friends, and several adventures along the way. The camp fee is \$35 each week with a one time \$20 registration fee.
