SENIOR INVESTMENT was unhurried early while off the rail, fanned into the seven path entering the lane, rallied in the stretch and was just up while three wide in the final stages. WEST COAST was back early on along the five path, shifted into the four path in the far turn, took over command and drew clear in the stretch but was nailed at the wire while inside. NO DOZING checked very hard entering the first turn, chased the pace early along the inside, swung into the six path entering the lane, rallied in the stretch, made a late bid from between horses but did not have enough. TIME TO TRAVEL tracked the pace early, shifted into the three path in the far turn with the lead but faltered late in the stretch run. LOOKIN AT BLESSING was unhurried early, fanned into the seven path in the far turn and moved up in the stretch drive. CONVICT PIKE was well placed early, shifted into the three path in the far turn and faded late in the stretch. SOUPER TAPIT was bothered at the start, checked hard and clipped heels entering the first turn, settled down the backstretch, was off the rail entering the lane and was empty down the lane. HE'S MUNNIE chased the pace early, fanned into the eight path in the far turn and was tired down the lane. CAPT. GRIDER was never involved. RESILIENCY came out at the start, set the pace for a half then stopped.
