FOR THREE YEAR OLDS. By subscription of \$150 each, which should accompany the nomination or by Supplementary Nomination of \$6,000 at time of entry (includes entry and starting fees). \$1,000 to enter and an additional \$1,000 to start, with \$200,000 guaranteed, of which \$120,000 to the owner of the winner plus 20 Road To The Kentucky Derby Points, \$40,000 to second plus 8 Road To The Kentucky Derby Points, \$20,000 to third plus 4 Road To The Kentucky Derby Points, \$10,000 to fourth plus 2 Road To The Kentucky Derby Points, \$6,000 to fifth and \$4,000 to be divided equally among sixth through last. Weight: 123 lbs. Non-winners of a Grade I or II stakes at a mile or over allowed 3 lbs.; \$55,000 at a mile or over since November 1, 5 lbs. The maximum number of starters for the Stonestreet Lexington will be limited to fourteen. In the event that more than fourteen pass the entry box, the fourteen starters will be determined at that time with preference given to graded stakes winners (in order I-II-III), then highest earnings. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. Keeneland will present a trophy cup to the owner of the winner. Closed Wednesday, March 27, 2019 with 65 nominations.

OWENDALE was unhurried early on, shifted into the four path in the far turn, swept past down the lane and took command, drew clear and held sway in the final stages. ANOTHERWISTAFATE was bothered shortly after leaving the gate, stalked the pace early along the backstretch, was boxed in from the half mile pole to the quarter pole, had a clear path once in the stretch but flattened out late in the drive. SUENO was bothered shortly after leaving the gate and raced back early on, fanned into the five path in the far turn, made a bid in the stretch with some gain in the final stages. KNICKS GO darted in shortly after leaving the gate and bothered multiple foes, pressed the pace early, took over and led briefly inside the three eighths pole, shifted into the three path entering the lane and weakened late in the stretch run. SHANG was back early on, angled off the rail into the lane and leveled off late in the stretch drive. ROILAND trailed the field early on, fanned into the five path in the far turn and moved up in the stretch. HARVEY WALLBANGER was never a threat. ZENDEN stalked the pace early, shifted into the four path in the far turn while making a bid but was empty down the lane. HAWAIIAN NOISES set the pace

for a half then folded up. CHASE THE GHOST was bothered after leaving the gate, chased the pace early, fanned into the five path in the far turn while making a bid but faded late in the stretch.
