Footnotes

OMAHA BEACH settled from the start, angled four wide on the first turn, bid at the seven-eighths pole to take the lead, led in the four path and was kept to task. IMPROBABLE was restless in the gate, was backed out and reloaded, settled, angled five wide at the half pole, bid outside of the winner but couldn't catch that one. COUNTRY HOUSE was unrushed, bid five wide at the quarter pole, but couldn't close. LAUGHING FOX raced inside, angled three wide in the stretch, then had a mild late bid. GALILEAN raced in the two path and improved position late. LONG RANGE TODDY pressed the pace in the three path, then faded in the stretch. JERSEY AGENDA pressed the pace between foes and gave way in the stretch. TIKHVIN FLEW raced evenly. GRAY ATTEMPT stalked the pace inside, was steadied on the first turn, angled three wide on the far turn, then faded in the stretch. SIX SHOOTER saved ground. ONE FLEW SOUTH was clear early, then pressed the pace inside for a half mile and gave way.
